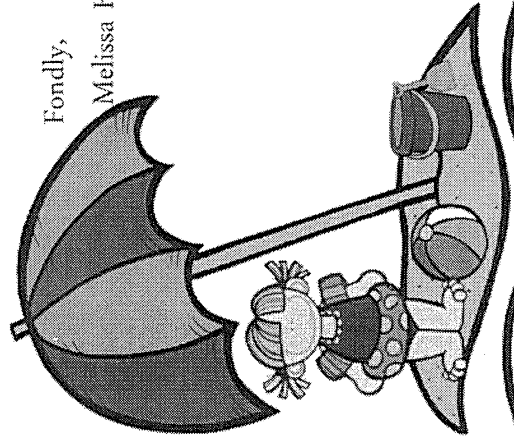


2021 Summer Calendar

Dear Parents,


