Things to Think About...

- 1) *Completes Quality Work* – Are you turning in all of your work? Is your work neat? Is it complete? Do you have full and complete sentences and are showing all work? Is the quality of your work at grade level?
- 2) *Is Prepared to Learn* – Do you have all your materials? Do you constantly have to ask others for materials, or borrow from the teacher? Do you have all of your assignments?
- 3) *Participates in Learning* – Do you participate orally during class discussions? Are you actively helping fellow students during group projects? Are you completing classwork without prompting from the teacher? Are you taking notes in class whenever possible?
- 4) *Follows Classroom Expectations* – Are you following classroom/school rules? Are you disruptive during class? Are you staying focused on the lesson and your work during class time?
- 5) *Shows Appropriate Behavior/Social Development* – Are you displaying appropriate behavior for a junior high student? Are you respectful toward your fellow classmates, teachers, and staff? Are you acting responsibly in all of your roles as an OLG student?
- 6) *Embodies SLE/Catholic Identity* – Are you living and acting by the 4 Dominican Pillars: prayer, study, community, ministry? Are you trying your best to adhere to our Student Learning Expectations?
