

# CATHOLIC CORNER

## MOSES


On this Third Sunday of Lent we read about Moses. God chose Moses to lead the Israelites out of the slavery of Egypt into the promised land of freedom. Jesus is sometimes called the "New Moses" because he led us out of our slavery to sin and death and into the new and eternal life of God.

He did this with his whole life and especially through his death and resurrection. The story today tells us about a time when the people following Moses in the desert were very thirsty. God used

Moses to give them water to drink and so saved them from dying.



At the Easter Vigil we will hear about Moses parting the waters of the Red Sea and saving the Israelites from death by letting them pass through the sea on dry land.



God does the same for us today in the water of baptism. In this water we are born again as children of God. We are promised that if we believe and follow Jesus we will have eternal life. Say a prayer thanking God for claiming you as one of God's own in baptism. Each time you enter the church, renew your baptism by dipping your hand in the holy water font and blessing yourself with the sign of the cross.
