## LITURGICAL UPDATE

The General Dispensation from the Sunday Obligation is no longer in effect. Only those who are considered high risk (i.e., those who are immune deficient, elderly, etc.) or living in communities with stricter protocols are dispensed. This dispensation will re-main in effect until further notice.

- We will continue to live stream Saturday 4:30pm Vigil and Sunday 11:00am Mass for those who are una-unable to attend in person.
- We ask that those who are unable to attend Mass in person use social media to attend your Sunday obligation and pray the prayer for Spiritual Communion.

**Some Ministries are still limited at the present time.** • Music is suspended at Mass until further notice

- Priest, deacons and seminarians will be the regular ministers of Holy Communion
- No Altar Servers at this time
- Sacristans may serve if they wish

**During our worship, we will continue to**

- Refrain from handshakes and embraces at Mass
- Refrain from holding hands through the Our Father
- We will also refrain from the Sign of Peace
- Cease distributing the Precious Blood

### Holy Communion

- The safest way to receive Communion is in the hand.
- Those who opt for Communion on the tongue should approach the priest after Mass.

### Offertory

- Baskets will not be passed for a collection. Parishioners may drop their offering off in the offering box/basket. We will not have gift-bearers.

### Social Distancing

1. Alaskans are encouraged to continue to follow health and hygiene protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19, including:

- Wash hands frequently;
- Stay home if you are sick, and get tested for COVID-19 if you have symptoms;
- Pews are marked with orange tape to encourage so-cial distancing.
- Families may sit together; others should maintain a 6 foot distance from those of another household.
- Wear a face covering in public places when near others.
- Be mindful and respectful to those Alaskans that are most vulnerable to this virus, including Alaska's senior population and those with existing health conditions.
