Please keep in mind that signing up for a slot does not necessarily lock you into one job only. There are numerous jobs to be done around the kitchen and the church in general that all go toward supporting the mission of the soup, kitchen, just like the soup kitchen supports the mission of ICC (and the diocese as a whole). As an example: prepping food roasters for the week; cleaning the refrigerators and appliances; clearing the pathways of snow and ice; sweeping/ mopping/vacuuming floors; etc. The critical days volunteers are needed are Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursdays. If you are available even for one day, your help would be greatly appreciated. While the kitchen is not operating on Mondays, we can still use the volunteer help for tasks like the odd jobs I listed above. Thank you all for your help here at the soup kitchen. It's the time and talent that folks like you give to the kitchen that really makes the mission possible!
