CHRISM MASS

The annual Chrism Mass, at which the Holy Oils are blessed and the priests renew their ordination promises, will be celebrated by Bishop Zielinski on **Tuesday, March 16 at 7:00pm** at Sacred Heart Cathedral.

During this liturgy, the three sacramental oils used by all our churches during the year will be consecrated; *Chrism...* for anointing the newly baptized, sealing candidates for confirmation, and dedicating new churches and altars...*Oil of Catechumens*, used for anointing those preparing for baptism...and *Oil of the Sick*, used to offer comfort, support and healing to the aged and infirm. A set of holy oils, to be used in the year ahead, will be distributed to each parish or ministry.

During the Year of St. Joseph, proclaimed by Pope Francis, there will be a special Mass celebrated at Sacred Heart Cathedral at 7:00pm on Friday, March 19 to mark the solemnity of the universal patron of the Church.
