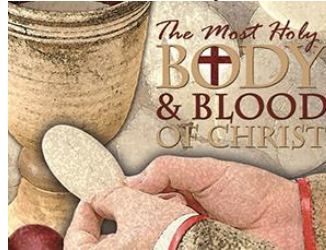

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

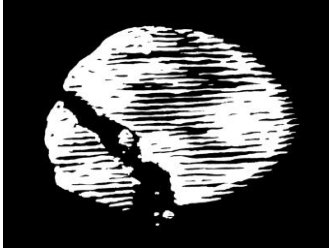
is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast is celebrated on the Thursday following the Trinity Sunday or, as in the USA, on the Sunday following that feast. This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist.

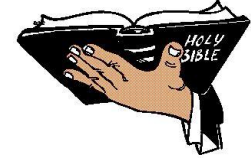

Sunday's Reflections
1 Corinthians 10:16-17

REAL COMMUNION

“The Body of Christ” refers to the church as well as to the Eucharist. When we share in the Body and Blood of Christ, we have communion with God and with one another.

Jesus is present to us in many ways. We hear his voice in the gospel. We experience his love in our community. We receive him sacramentally in the Eucharist. We are called the Body of Christ because Christ dwells with us.

St. Paul wrote the Corinthians, “Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf.”

When we receive communion, we experience our communion with one another. Many though we are, we are one in Christ. Just as many grains of wheat make one loaf, just as one loaf is shared by many people, just as many people become one by sharing that one loaf, so do we many become one in Christ. Jesus unites our community when we share our communion together.

Paul's words were especially significant to the Corinthians. He began this letter addressing the divisions in their church and calling the faithful there to unity. At this point in his letter, we understand why. Their unity in the church is critical to the integrity of their worship.

If our Eucharist is to be sincere, our communion must be real. We eat the Body of Christ. We drink the Blood of Christ. We are the Body of Christ.
