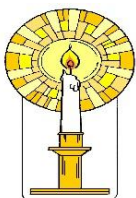

Sunday's Reflections
Hebrews 2:9-11

LOVING THE FUTURE

A lot of us have a good life today because our ancestors sacrificed. Some of them worked the land by the sweat of their brow. Some left their home in one country and took a hard journey to another. Others came unwillingly and worked as slaves for those with power. Our ancestors wanted a better future. They sacrificed for it. They knew they might not enjoy the finer things of life. But they hoped their children would.

At our worst, our generation spends more than it saves. It enjoys the present more than it plans for the future. Many of us have forgotten the sacrifices of the past and the character of our ancestors. We will not sacrifice until we love the future—until we care enough about a generation yet to be born.

Jesus Christ loved the future and gave his life for generations yet to be born. The Letter to the Hebrews, commenting on Psalm 8, says that Jesus “‘for a little while’ was made ‘lower than the angels,’ that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.” When Jesus came to save us, he did not come as a great king, a wealthy businessman, or a pampered adolescent. He came in order to taste death, and so bring us to glory.

We have a good life because of our ancestors. We have a rich spiritual inheritance because of Christ. Sacrificial love prepares for future generations.
