**Reflexiones del domingo**
*Filipenses 2: 6-11*
**VIDA EXTENUANTE**

El Domingo de Ramos experimentamos la grandeza y la pobreza del espíritu humano. Cuando Jesús entró en Jerusalén, las multitudes lo aclamaron como el Hijo de David. Pero cuando fue juzgado ante Pilato, las mismas multitudes pidieron su crucifixión.

El domingo de Ramos, cerca del final de la Cuaresma, hemos estado en contacto con la grandeza y la pobreza de nuestras propias vidas. A lo largo de esta temporada, hemos reflexionado sobre nuestro pecado, pero también hemos experimentado la gracia de Dios en la comunión, la comunidad y las Escrituras.

En el Domingo de Ramos, también escuchamos acerca de la grandeza y la pobreza de Jesús. Jesús estaba en la forma de Dios, pero tomó forma humana. Él tenía toda la grandeza como Dios, pero no se aferraba a ella.

La carta de San Pablo a los filipenses dice: "Más bien, se vació a sí mismo, tomando la forma de un esclavo". Jesús se humilló a sí mismo para ser como nosotros y experimentar lo que experimentamos, incluso la muerte. "Debido a esto, Dios lo exaltó grandemente y le otorgó el nombre que está sobre todo nombre".

A veces, en un solo día experimentamos una alegría sin restricciones y un dolor inconsolable. Un niño nace, pero alguien muere. Recibimos misericordia de un extraño, pero no amamos a nuestro prójimo. Los extremos de la vida humana son vastos. Pero Cristo vino a nosotros abrazando ambos extremos y todo lo que está en el medio. Todo, toda la vida humana que redime y hace suya

**Sunday's Reflections**
*Philippians 2:6-11*
**EXTREME LIFE**

On Palm Sunday we experience the greatness and the poverty of the human spirit. As Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds acclaimed him as the Son of David. But as he stood trial before Pilate, the same crowds called for his crucifixion.

On Palm Sunday, near the end of Lent, we have come in touch with the greatness and poverty of our own lives. Throughout this season we have reflected on our sin, but we have also experienced God's grace in communion, community, and scripture.

On Palm Sunday, we also hear about the greatness and poverty of Jesus. Jesus was in the form of God, but he took on human form. He had all greatness as God, but he did not cling to it.

St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians says, "Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave." Jesus humbled himself to become like us and to experience what we experience—even death. "Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name."

Sometimes in a single day we experience unfettered joy and inconsolable grief. A child is born, but someone dies. We receive mercy from a stranger, but we fail to love our neighbor. The extremes of human life are vast. But Christ came to us embracing both extremes and all that is in the middle. All, all of human life he redeems and makes his own.
