Reflexiones del domingo
Apocalipsis 1: 9-11a, 12-13, 17-19
VISION DEL DOMINGO

La Pascua deja atrás las penurias de la Cuaresma. Muchos de nosotros aceptamos esos desafíos libremente: soportamos seis semanas de penitencia en un espíritu de arrepentimiento y con un deseo de renovación. Pero algunas personas no preguntan por las dificultades que reciben, dificultades que son mucho más de lo que cualquier Cuaresma haya inducido.

Por ejemplo, pocas personas deben soportar el tipo de persecución que afectó a la iglesia primitiva. A lo largo de la temporada de Pascua de este año, la iglesia nos invita a escuchar varios pasajes del Libro de la Revelación, un libro compuesto durante un tiempo de persecución religiosa. Inspiró a sus lectores a mantener su fe fuerte y a seguir avanzando hacia un día más brillante.

Al comienzo del libro, John dice que comparte la angustia que sus lectores soportan. Se encontró en una isla, tal vez en el exilio, porque "proclamó la palabra de Dios y dio testimonio de Jesús".

Su visión tuvo lugar en el día del Señor, el domingo. Aunque estaba lleno de miedo, uno "como un hijo de hombre" se le apareció y le dijo: "No tengas miedo". Soy el primero y el último, el que vive. Una vez estuve muerto, pero ahora estoy vivo para siempre jamás".

Independientemente de los problemas que enfrentemos, nuestra celebración en el día del Señor nos debe otorgar una visión que no tenemos nada que temer. El que murió ahora vive, y nos guiará a través de los próximos días.

Sunday's Reflections
Revelation 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19
SUNDAY VISION

Easter puts behind us the hardships of Lent. Many of us accepted those challenges freely—we endured six weeks of penance in a spirit of contrition and with a desire for renewal. But some people do not ask for the difficulties they receive—hardships that are much more than any Lent ever induced.

For example, few people must endure the kind of persecution that plagued the early church. Throughout the Easter season this year, the church invites us to hear several passages from the Book of Revelation, a book composed during a time of religious persecution. It inspired its readers to keep their faith strong and to press on to a brighter day.

At the beginning of the book, John says he shares the distress his readers endure. He found himself on an island—perhaps in exile—because he "proclaimed God's word and gave testimony to Jesus."

His vision took place on the Lord's day—Sunday. Although he was filled with fear, one "like a son of man" appeared to him and said, "Do not be afraid. I am the first and the last, the one who lives. Once I was dead, but now I am alive forever and ever."

Whatever the troubles we face, our celebration on the Lord's day should grant us a vision that we have nothing to fear. The one who died now lives, and he will guide us through the days ahead.
