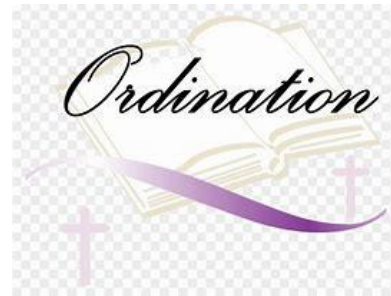
ARE YOU RECEIVING THE WEST TEXAS ANGELUS?

DIOCESAN IMMIGRATION SERVICES AVAILABLE

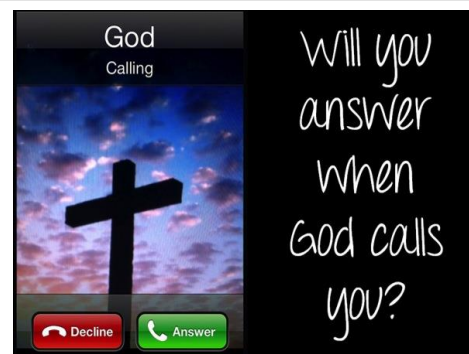

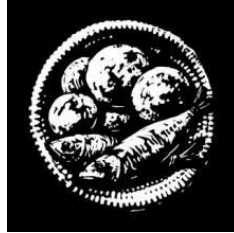

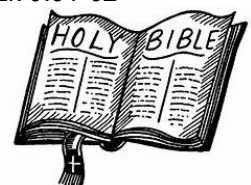

Reflexiones del domingo
1 Corintios 11: 23-26
LA PRIMERA CUENTA DE LA ÚLTIMA CENA

La primera descripción registrada de la Eucaristía proviene de la Primera Carta de Pablo a los Corintios. Es incluso más antiguo que los evangelios. Antes de que los evangelistas escribieran sobre la última cena, Pablo ya había enviado una carta a la iglesia en Corinto, describiendo lo que había sucedido.

Pablo dice que su versión ya es parte de una tradición. "Recibí del Señor lo que también te transmití". Es decir, que Jesús tomó pan y vino la noche antes de morir. Dio las gracias, partió el pan y dijo: "Este es mi cuerpo que es para ti. Haz esto en memoria mía ". Haz esto, informa Pablo. Tomando la copa, Jesús la pronunció como la copa del "nuevo pacto en mi sangre. Haz esto, con frecuencia como lo bebas, en memoria de mí". Con frecuencia, informa Paul. Haz esto con mucha frecuencia.

"Porque cuando comes este pan y bebes la copa, proclamas la muerte del Señor hasta que él venga", dice Pablo.

Nos reunimos a menudo para la eucaristía. Todavía llevamos a cabo uno de los rituales más antiguos y sin duda más ricos de la tradición cristiana. Y cada vez que comemos y bebemos el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo, proclamamos la muerte del Señor hasta que él venga.

Es un privilegio compartir esta comida. Lo hemos heredado de una larga tradición. Y con ello heredó una responsabilidad: proclamar la muerte del Señor hasta que él venga. Con frecuencia.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Corinthians 11:23-26
THE FIRST ACCOUNT OF THE LAST SUPPER

The earliest recorded description of the Eucharist comes from Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. It is even older than the gospels. Before the evangelists wrote about the Last Supper, Paul had already sent a letter to the church in Corinth, describing what had happened.

Paul says his version is already part of a tradition. "I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you." Namely, that Jesus took bread and wine on the night before he died. He gave thanks, broke the bread, and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." Do this, Paul reports. Taking the cup, Jesus pronounced it as the cup of "the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." Often, Paul reports. Do this often.

"For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes," Paul says.

We gather for Eucharist often. We still carry out one of the oldest and certainly the richest rituals in the Christian tradition. And whenever we eat and drink the body and blood of Christ, we proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes.

It is a privilege to share this meal. We have inherited it from a long tradition. And with it inherited a responsibility—to proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes. Often.
