*Galatas 6:14-18*
**CICATRIZ**

"¿Le gustaría ver mi cicatriz?". Escuchamos esta pregunta de algunas personas que se han sometido a una cirugía, se han salido de su motocicleta o han sufrido una herida en la guerra. A veces están más ansiosos por mostrarlo que nosotros por verlo.

Lo contrario sucede también. Nos gustaría ver una cicatriz, pero la persona, por razones privadas, elige no mostrarla.

Todos llevamos cicatrices. Algunos son físicos y bastante visibles. Otros están bien ocultos. Algunas cicatrices son emocionales. Se dan a conocer incluso cuando nos gustaría que no lo hicieran. Y algunas de nuestras cicatrices nos hacen quienes somos. Son signos de nuestra capacidad de recuperación, de las malas intenciones de los enemigos, de los momentos de insensatez o de inimaginable valentía. Para algunos de nosotros, nuestra biografía es la historia de nuestras cicatrices

San Pablo les dice a los gálatas: "Llevo las marcas de Jesús en mi cuerpo". Pablo tenía su parte de dolor físico y emocional, y tenía cicatrices. No eran signos de dolor y dolor, ni signos de tontería o valentía, ni signos de enfermedad o traición. Eran signos de Jesús. Por causa de Jesús, Pablo soportó todas las cosas. Sus cicatrices decían menos sobre la tenacidad de Pablo, y más sobre la fidelidad de Cristo.

**Sunday's Reflections**
*Galatians 6:14-18*
**SCAR TISSUE**

"Would you like to see my scar?" We hear this question from some people who have had surgery, scraped the road from their motorcycle, or suffered a wound in war. Sometimes they are more anxious to show it than we are to see it.

The reverse happens too. We would like to see a scar, but the person—for private reasons—chooses not to show it.

We all carry scars. Some are physical and quite visible. Others are well concealed. Some scars are emotional. They make themselves known even when we wish they did not. And some of our scars make us who we are. They are signs of our resilience, of the ill-intent of enemies, of moments of foolishness, or times of unimaginable bravery. For some of us, our biography is the story of our scars.

St. Paul tells the Galatians, "I bear the marks of Jesus on my body." Paul had his share of physical and emotional pain, and he carried scars. They were not signs of hurt and pain, no signs of foolishness or bravery, not signs of illness or treachery. They were signs of Jesus. Because of Jesus, Paul endured all things. His scars told less about the tenacity of Paul, and more about the faithfulness of Christ.

Where are your scars? What do they represent? Who do they represent? Do you conceal them? Or do you ask, "Would you like to see my scar?"
