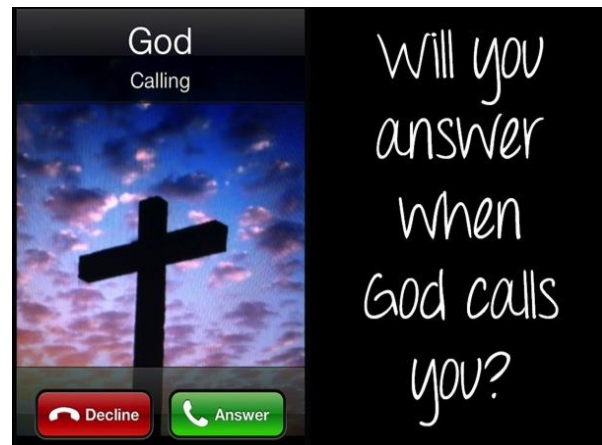

Reflexiones del domingo
Colosenses 1: 15-20
CREANDO LA VIDA, HACIENDO LA PAZ

A muchas veces la persona adecuada puede hacer que las cosas sucedan. En la familia, un negocio, un club o un coro, el entusiasmo y la experiencia que aporta una persona pueden hacer que todas las partes trabajen juntas.

En algunas familias, hay una persona que reúne a las personas, y que las hace reír y llorar, celebrar quiénes son y atender a los menos afortunados. En algunos negocios, hay una persona con la visión correcta para diseñar un proyecto que hace una diferencia real en la vida de las personas. Incluso en la escuela, una persona puede dar a una clase su carácter, un líder natural cuya creatividad trae vida y cuya compasión ayuda a los enemigos a hacer la paz.

De alguna manera, esas imágenes explican el papel de Cristo en el universo. La Carta a los Colosenses dice que él es "el primogénito de toda la creación" y el "primogénito de entre los muertos". "En él se crearon todas las cosas en el cielo y en la tierra". Él es el primero en levantarse de entre los muertos, "que en todas las cosas, él mismo podría ser preeminente". De esta manera, Cristo Jesús es el primero de todo.

Pero Cristo es también la unidad de todo. Porque él es el primogénito de toda la creación, "en él todas las cosas se mantienen juntas". Debido a que él es el primogénito de entre los muertos, reconcilia todas las cosas, "haciendo la paz por la sangre de su cruz".

Podemos esforzarnos por crear vida y traer paz, pero lo hacemos como discípulos de Cristo.

Sunday's Reflections
Colossians 1:15-20
CREATING LIFE, MAKING PEACE

Often the right person can make things happen. In the family, a business, a club, or a choir, the enthusiasm and expertise that one person brings can make all the parts work together.

In some families, there is one person who gathers people together, and who makes them laugh and cry, celebrate who they are, and tend to those less fortunate. In some business, there is one person with the right vision to fashion a project that makes a real difference in peoples' lives. Even at school, one person might give a class its character, a natural leader whose creativity brings life and whose compassion helps enemies make peace.

In some small way, those images explain the role of Christ in the universe. The Letter to the Colossians says he is "the firstborn of all creation" and "firstborn from the dead." "In him were created all things in heaven and on earth." He is the first to rise from the dead, "that in all things he himself might be preeminent." In these ways, Christ Jesus is the first of everything.

But Christ is also the unity of everything. Because he is the firstborn of all creation, "in him all things hold together." Because he is the firstborn from the dead, he reconciles all things, "making peace by the blood of his cross."

We may strive to create life and to bring peace, but we do it as disciples of Christ
