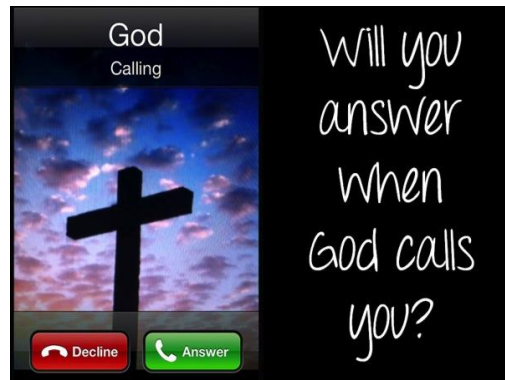

Reflexiones del domingo
Colosenses 1: 24-28
NO SUFICIENTE SUFRIMIENTO

Hay demasiado sufrimiento en el mundo. Todos estan de acuerdo. Hay demasiada enfermedad, demasiada enemistad, demasiados celos, demasiada violencia, demasiada pobreza, demasiada ansiedad y demasiada muerte.

Es extraño, entonces, escuchar la Carta a los Colosenses que implica que aún no ha habido suficiente sufrimiento. Pablo dice: "Ahora me regocijo en mis sufrimientos por tu causa, y en mi carne estoy llenando lo que falta en las aflicciones de Cristo".

Ciertamente, no había nada "faltante" en las aflicciones de Cristo: abandonado por sus amigos, traicionado por un apóstol, arrestado y maltratado, acusado falsamente, golpeado y azotado, hecho para llevar el instrumento de su tortura, y clavado en él, luego Levantado alto, morir, en una cruz. Nada faltaba.

Sin embargo, el sufrimiento ha continuado. Algunas personas han conocido dolores, torturas y dolores aún más que eso. La cruz de Cristo no acabó sufriendo. Pero dejó el sufrimiento impotente ante la gloria de la cruz. Pablo dice que se regocija con sus sufrimientos "para completar para usted la Palabra de Dios, el misterio escondido desde los siglos y las generaciones pasadas". Ese misterio ahora se manifiesta: "Es Cristo en ustedes, la esperanza de la gloria".

Se siente como si hubiéramos tenido demasiado sufrimiento, pero incluso si hay más, no puede hacernos daño. El sufrimiento no tiene poder antes de la promesa de gloria en Cristo.

Sunday's Reflections
Colossians 1:24-28
NOT ENOUGH SUFFERING

There is too much suffering in the world. Everyone agrees. There is too much sickness, too much enmity, too much jealousy, too much violence, too much poverty, too much anxiety, and too much death.

It is strange then to hear the Letter to the Colossians imply there has not yet been enough suffering. Paul says, "Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ."

Certainly there was nothing "lacking" in the afflictions of Christ—abandoned by his friends, betrayed by an apostle, arrested and manhandled, falsely accused, beaten, and flogged, made to carry the instrument of his torture, and nailed to it, then lifted high, to die, on a cross. Nothing was lacking.

Yet suffering has continued. Some people have known sorrows, torture, and pain even worse than that. The cross of Christ did not end suffering. But it rendered suffering powerless before the glory of the cross. Paul says he rejoices in his sufferings "to bring to completion for you the word of God, the mystery hidden from ages and from generations past." That mystery is now made manifest: "It is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

It feels like we have had too much suffering, but even if there is more, it cannot harm us. Suffering has no power before the promise of glory in Christ.
