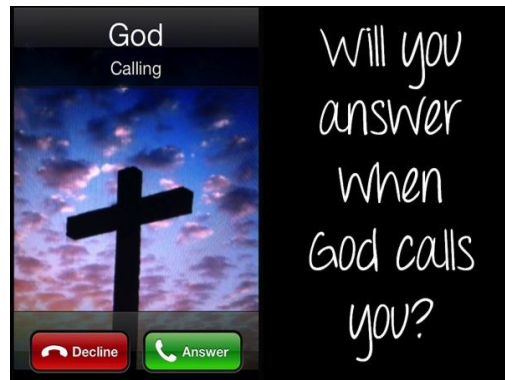

Colosenses 2: 12-14
LA MEJOR POLITICA

Nuestra sociedad se burla de los abogados, pero hay veces en que los necesitamos, y uno bueno no tiene precio. Si ha sido acusado erróneamente, necesita ayuda para borrar el registro. Si tiene una multa de tráfico, quiere que alguien presente su lado. Si usted es culpable y lo sabe, y no quiere salir de eso, solo quiere admitirlo, para traer la paz a usted y a su vecino: un buen abogado puede ayudarlo a tomar medidas valientes para un recompensando la vida.

Cada vez que pecamos, nos sentimos tentados a mentir al respecto y hacer que alguien mienta con nosotros. Enfrentarse a la verdad parece tan horrible, que preferiríamos encubrirlo.

Pero eso no es libertad. Eso es esclavitud a la falsedad. Libertad es admitir nuestro error, aceptar las consecuencias y darse cuenta de quiénes somos y de lo que creemos.

La Carta a los Colosenses dice que Cristo se ha ocupado de nuestras transgresiones. Él los ha perdonado, "destruyendo el vínculo contra nosotros, con sus reclamos legales, que se oponía a nosotros". Cristo hizo más de lo que un abogado típico podía hacer. Es abogado, víctima y juez. Él es aquel contra quien hemos pecado, el que aboga por nosotros y el que puede decidir el castigo. Con todo ese poder, Cristo elige el perdón.

Cuando somos honestos, Cristo nos hace libres.

Sunday's Reflections
Colossians 2:12-14
THE BEST POLICY

Our society makes fun of lawyers, but there are times when we need them, and a good one is priceless. If you have been wrongly accused, you need help to clear the record. If you have a traffic ticket, you want someone to present your side. If you are guilty, and you know it, and you do not want to get out of it, you just want to admit it, to bring peace to yourself and your neighbor—a good lawyer can help you make courageous steps to a new and rewarding life.

Whenever we sin, we are tempted to lie about it, and to get someone to lie with us. Facing the truth seems so horrible, that we would rather cover it up.

But that is not freedom. That is slavery to falsehood. Freedom is admitting our wrong, accepting the consequences, and realizing who we are and what we believe.

The Letter to the Colossians says that Christ has taken care of our transgressions. He has forgiven them, "obliterating the bond against us, with its legal claims, which was opposed to us." Christ did more than a typical lawyer could do. He is lawyer, victim, and judge. He is the one against whom we have sinned, the one who advocates on our behalf, and the one who can decide the punishment. With all that power, Christ chooses forgiveness.

When we are honest, Christ makes us free.
