Colosenses 3: 1-5, 9-11
AHÍ VA EL VECINDARIO

El lugar donde vives determina cómo vives. Si vive en un departamento, debe tener en cuenta a sus vecinos. Si comparte una asociación de propietarios, debe seguir sus reglas. Incluso si tiene una casa privada en una comunidad cerrada, debe pagar impuestos y mantenerse al día con las facturas.

¿Dónde vives? No, no es tu dirección. No es el número del departamento. No es tu calle o vecindario. No es la ciudad que elegiste por su belleza o proximidad al trabajo. ¿Dónde vives? Vives con Cristo.

La Carta a los Colosenses llama a los hermanos y hermanas cristianos aquellos que "fueron criados con Cristo". Y les dice, en una hermosa frase, dónde viven: "Tu vida está escondida con Cristo en Dios".

Debido a que fuimos criados con Cristo, vivimos arriba, y debemos buscar las cosas que pertenecen a la vida de arriba, no a la vida de abajo. "Piensa en lo que está arriba, no en lo que está en la tierra".

Tenemos una dirección con clase. Vivimos con Cristo en Dios. El lugar donde vivimos determina cómo vivimos. Dejamos de lado las necesidades de la tierra: la inmoralidad, la impureza, la pasión, el mal deseo y la codicia. Adoptamos el camino de la libertad y la unidad. Es bueno para el barrio.

Sunday's Reflections
Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11
THERE GOES THE NEIGHBORHOOD

Where you live determines how you live. If you live in an apartment, you must be mindful of your neighbors. If you share a homeowners' association, you have to follow its rules. Even if you have a private home in a gated community, you must pay taxes and keep up with the bills.

Where do you live? No, not your address. Not the apartment number. Not your street or neighborhood. Not the town you chose because of its beauty or proximity to work. Where do you live? You live with Christ.

The Letter to the Colossians calls Christian brothers and sisters those who "were raised with Christ." And it tells them, in a beautiful phrase, where they live: "Your life is hidden with Christ in God."

Because we were raised with Christ, we live above, and we should seek the things that pertain to life above, not to life below. "Think of what is above, not of what is on earth."

We have a classy address. We live with Christ in God. Where we live determines how we live. We put aside the wants of the earth: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed. We adopt the way of freedom and unity. It's good for the neighborhood.

We are hidden with Christ in God. We are so close to Christ, that when he, our life, appears, we will appear with him in glory.
