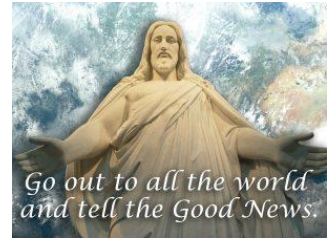

Reflexiones del domingo
Hebreos 12:5-7, 11-13
POR TU PROPIO BIEN

"Me lo agradecerás por esto algún día". Oh, cómo un niño odia escuchar esas palabras. A menudo acompañan algún castigo que los niños tienen que soportar hasta que crecen. Los niños se mueven bajo esas palabras. No tienen ningún sentido. Se llevan la diversión. Y los hacen enojar.

Pero esas palabras suelen ser correctas. Tal vez eso se suma a la frustración. Todos odiamos hacer lo que es "por nuestro propio bien" cuando parece que es todo lo contrario. No nos gusta que nos digan que hicimos algo incorrecto. No nos gusta que nos castiguen. Y no nos gusta que nos digan que fijemos nuestra actitud sobre el castigo.

Entonces, cuando la Carta a los Hebreos dice que Dios nos trata como niños, no suena como una buena noticia. El autor recuerda una cita del Antiguo Testamento. Es suficiente para hacerte hacer una mueca: "Hijo mío, no desdeñes la disciplina del Señor ni te desanimes cuando sea reprendido por él; a quien ama el Señor, él disciplina; azota a cada hijo que reconoce".

Entonces, aquí está el consejo que recibimos: "Soporten sus pruebas como 'disciplina'". Preferimos no tener que soportar las pruebas en absoluto. Pero cuando vienen, se supone que debemos soportarlos. "En ese momento, toda disciplina parece ser una causa no de alegría sino de dolor, pero más tarde trae el fruto pacífico de la justicia".

No nos gusta escucharlo, pero es cierto: algún día daremos gracias a Dios por estas pruebas.

Sunday's Reflections
Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13
FOR YOUR OWN GOOD

"You'll thank me for this one day." Oh, how a kid hates to hear those words. They often accompany some punishment that kids have to put up with until they get older. Kids seethe under those words. They do not make any sense. They take away fun. And they make them mad.

But those words are usually right. Maybe that adds to the frustration. We all hate to do what is "for our own good" when it feels like it is anything but. We do not like being told we did the wrong thing. We do not like to be punished. And we do not like being told to fix our attitude about punishment.

So when the Letter to the Hebrews says God treats us like children, it doesn't quite sound like good news. The author recalls a quote from the Old Testament. It is enough to make you wince: "My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines; he scourges every son he acknowledges."

So, here is the advice we get: "Endure your trials as 'discipline'." We would rather not have to endure trials at all. But when they come, we are supposed to endure them. "At the time, all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness."

We do not like hearing it, but it is true: Some day we will thank God for these trials.
