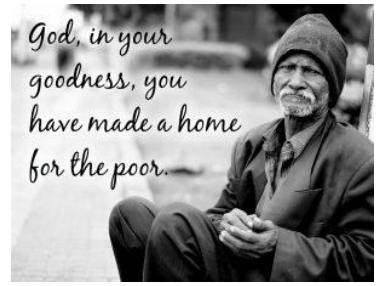

Hebreos 12:18-19, 22-24a
LA VOZ DE AUTORIDAD

Algunas personas se intimidan fácilmente. Tienen miedo de hablar con el jefe. No quieren visitar la oficina del director. Incluso pueden temer a un padre que aún ejerce poder sobre la decisión que toman los hijos.

¿De qué tiene miedo la gente? A menudo simplemente no quieren que se les grite. El volumen y el tono en la voz enojada de alguien con autoridad es suficiente para sacudirte el alma.

Moisés tuvo que enfrentar esa voz. Dios estaba estableciendo la ley y haciéndola en voz alta. Cuando Moisés visitó a Dios en el Monte Sinaí, se acercó a "un fuego abrasador y una oscuridad sombría y una tormenta y un sonido de trompeta y una voz que pronunciaba palabras de tal manera que los que escuchaban rogaban que ningún mensaje fuera dirigido a ellos". Fue tan temible que el Carta a los hebreos recordó este evento más de mil años después como si hubiera sucedido ayer

Cuando Moisés habló con Dios, tuvo que acercarse a una escena temible en el Monte Sinaí. Pero nosotros no. "No, te has acercado al Monte Sión". Vemos una visión diferente. Vemos "la ciudad del Dios viviente ... e innumerables ángeles en una reunión festiva, y la asamblea de los primogénitos inscritos en el cielo, y Dios el juez de todos, y los espíritus de los justos perfeccionados, y Jesús, el mediador de un nuevo pacto".

Nos acercamos a Jesús en oración sin sentirnos intimidados sino privilegiados de disfrutar de la reunión festiva de los justos hechos perfectos.

Sunday's Reflections
Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a
THE VOICE OF AUTHORITY

Some people get intimidated easily. They are afraid to speak to the boss. They do not want to visit the principal's office. They may even fear a parent who still exercises power over the decision's children make.

What are people afraid of? Oftentimes they just do not want to be yelled at. The volume and tone in the angry voice of someone in authority is enough to shake you to your soul.

Moses had to face that voice. God was laying down the law and doing it loudly. When Moses visited God on Mount Sinai, he approached "a blazing fire and gloomy darkness and storm and a trumpet blast and a voice speaking words such that those who heard begged that no message be further addressed to them." It was so fearsome that the Letter to the Hebrews remembered this event over a thousand years later as if it had happened yesterday.

When Moses talked with God, he had to approach a fearsome scene on Mount Sinai. But not us. "No, you have approached Mount Zion." We see a different vision. We see "the city of the living God, ..., and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all, and the spirits of the just made perfect, and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant."

We approach Jesus in prayer not feeling intimidated but privileged to enjoy the festal gathering of the just made perfect.
