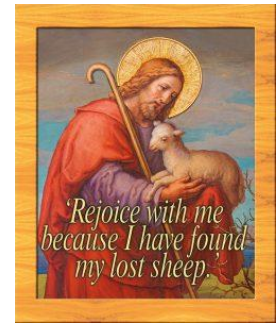

**Reflexiones del domingo**
*1 Timoteo 1: 12-17*
**CULPABLE COMO PECADO**

A veces somos más culpables de ignorancia que de pecado. No sabíamos que estábamos ofendiendo a alguien más. No sabíamos que estábamos rompiendo las reglas locales. No sabíamos que nos estábamos haciendo daño. No nos dimos cuenta de que Dios estaría disgustado. No siempre queremos hacer algo mal. A veces hacemos lo incorrecto por ignorancia.

Otras veces, sin embargo, pecamos. Deliberadamente elegimos lo que está mal. Nos convencemos por lo que parece una buena razón: es más fácil, nadie lo sabrá, será divertido, me lo merezco. Pero elegimos lo que está mal. Sabemos que está mal, y lo hacemos.

En ese momento puede sentirse bien. Pero luego experimentamos remordimiento. La culpa de nuestros pecados se sienta con nosotros más que el disfrute que tan brevemente extienden. ¿Qué puede restaurar nuestra paz?

Perdón. Y es por eso que Jesús vino. "Cristo Jesús vino al mundo para salvar a los pecadores", dice la primera carta a Timoteo. Jesús no vino al mundo para castigar a los pecadores, sino para salvarlos. El autor de la carta da este testimonio personal: "Fui tratado con misericordia, de modo que en mí, como el principal, Cristo Jesús podría mostrar toda su paciencia como un ejemplo para aquellos que llegarían a creer en él".

Ya sea que seamos culpables de ignorancia o pecado, Jesús ha venido a salvarnos. Esto lo creemos. Por esto le damos gloria.

**Sunday's Reflections**
*1 Timothy 1:12-17*
**GUILTY AS SIN**

Sometimes we are more guilty of ignorance than of sin. We did not know that we were offending someone else. We were not aware we were breaking local rules. We did not know we were hurting ourselves. We did not realize God would be displeased. We do not always mean to do something wrong. Sometimes we do the wrong thing out of ignorance.

Other times, though, we sin. We deliberately choose what is wrong. We talk ourselves into it for what seems like a good reason—it's easier, no one will know, it will be fun, I deserve it. But we choose what is wrong. We know it's wrong, and we do it.

At the time it may feel all right. But later we experience remorse. The guilt of our sins sits with us more than the enjoyment they so briefly extend. What can restore our peace?

Forgiveness. And that is why Jesus came. "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners," says the First Letter to Timothy. Jesus did not come into the world to punish sinners, but to save them. The author of the letter gives this personal testimony: "I was mercifully treated, so that in me, as the foremost, Christ Jesus might display all his patience as an example for those who would come to believe in him."

Whether we are guilty of ignorance or sin, Jesus has come to save us. This we believe. For this we give glory.
