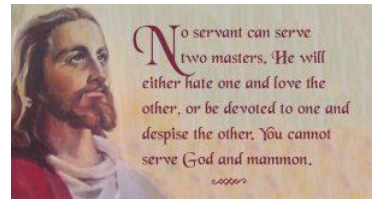

ORANDO POR LA AUTORIDAD

Pero es un poco sorprendente escuchar lo que viene después. Luego viene un ejemplo de por quién debemos orar. No es el enfermo. No es la familia. Ni siquiera es el pobre. Las oraciones deben ofrecerse primero "para reyes y para todos en autoridad". ¿Qué dice? "Reyes y todos en autoridad".

Hay una razón: "para que podamos llevar una vida tranquila y tranquila con toda devoción y dignidad".

Las personas en cargos públicos necesitan nuestras oraciones más de lo que nos damos cuenta. Necesitamos que gobiernen para que nos ayuden a llevar una vida tranquila y digna.

Cuando ores por los necesitados, recuerda a los que están en cargos públicos.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Timothy 2:1-8
PRAYING FOR AUTHORITY

Our list of people to pray for is long. We pray for members of our family. We pray for friends. We pray for the sick. We remember the dying. We also ask God to care for the dead. We know people in financial trouble, parents with difficult children, and children with difficult parents. We even pray for our sports team to win. Whenever there is a need, we are happy to pray. We cannot always solve someone else's problem, but we can pray for them, and lend our voice to the chorus appealing for God's ear.

The First Letter to Timothy thinks such prayers are a good idea. "I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone." So, the bible approves the idea of praying for others.

But it is a little surprising to hear what comes next. Next comes an example of whom we should pray for. It is not the sick. It is not the family. It is not even the poor. Prayers should first be offered "for kings and for all in authority." Say what? "Kings and all in authority."

There is a reason: "that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity."

People in public office need our prayers more than we realize. We need them to govern so that they help us lead a tranquil, dignified life.

When you pray for the needy, remember those in public office.
