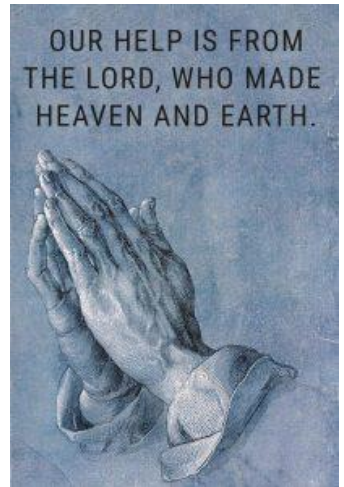

2 Timoteo 3:14-4:2

BIBLIAS CATOLICAS

Solía ser que los católicos no conocían muy bien la Biblia. Cada hogar católico tenía una Biblia, pero solo se usaba como libro de registro. En él se inscribieron las estadísticas vitales de los miembros de la familia. Cuando el abuelo murió. Cuando tía Tillie se casó. Cuando nació la prima Susie. Todo estaba allí, escrito con mucho cuidado en aras de la precisión, la belleza y el testimonio de la fe.

Ahora es diferente. Todavía podemos usar nuestras Biblias para los registros, pero también las usamos para la oración, tanto individualmente como en familia. Incluso en la iglesia, los católicos escuchan las lecturas de la Biblia en cada servicio. Hemos abierto nuestros corazones a la palabra de Dios en la iglesia y en el hogar.

Sunday's Reflections

2 Timothy 3:14—4:2

CATHOLIC BIBLES

It used to be that Catholics did not know the Bible very well at all. Every Catholic home had a Bible, but it was used only as a record book. Into it were inscribed the vital statistics of family members. When Grandpa died. When Aunt Tillie got married. When Cousin Susie was born. It was all in there, penned very carefully for the sake of accuracy, beauty, and the testimony of faith.

Now it is different. We may still use our Bibles for records, but we also use them for prayer, both as individuals and as a family. Even at church, Catholics hear readings from the Bible at every service. We have opened our hearts to the word of God in church and at home.

It is a big book. We will never explore it fully. But we are getting more comfortable with it as a source of inspiration and direction. It is a good thing.

The Second Letter to Timothy says, "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that one who belongs to God may be competent, equipped for every good work."

We who belong to God use the Bible as our guide. It equips us for every good work. Whenever we have questions, problems, curiosities, or a desire to give praise, the Bible is there for our use. Are you using yours?
