Reflexiones del domingo

2 Timoteo 2:6-8, 16-18

LA BUENA LUCHA

Todos admiramos a las personas que se mantienen firmes frente a toda oposición. Superan las probabilidades. Se recuperan de la confianza mal colocada. Hablan como si tuvieran sentido para sí mismos, incluso si nadie está de acuerdo. Creen firmemente, no débilmente. Tienen valores y principios. Piensan que el mundo debería ser de otra manera. Mantienen viva su visión en medio de la crítica y el ridículo.

Cuando alguien así muere, oírás a la gente decir: "Ella peleó la buena batalla". O él lo hizo. Es una expresión maravillosa. Implica que la vida fue una lucha, pero la lucha valió la pena, y que esta persona participó en la lucha hasta el final. "Peleó la buena batalla".

Esta expresión proviene de la Segunda Carta a Timoteo, donde se escucha hoy en una forma ligeramente diferente: "He competido bien; He terminado la carrera; He mantenido la fe". Poder decir eso es un gran testimonio. "He peleado la buena batalla".

Significa que la fe es una lucha, pero que vale la pena. Significa que nos hemos enfrentado a la oposición. Puede que no hayamos ganado la carrera, pero la hemos terminado.

Cuando perseveramos en nuestras luchas, no pasa desapercibido. Incluso si nunca logramos todos nuestros objetivos, hemos logrado la lucha, y eso trae su propia recompensa. Puede no parecer tan satisfactorio, pero impresiona a muchas otras personas. Y le agrada a Dios.

Sunday's Reflections

2 Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18

THE GOOD FIGHT

We all admire people who hold their ground in the face of all opposition. They overcome the odds. They recover from poorly placed trust. They talk like they make sense to themselves even if no one agrees. They believe strongly, not weakly. They have values and principles. They think the world should be another way. They keep their vision alive during criticism and ridicule.

When someone like that dies, you will hear people say, "She fought the good fight." Or he did. It is a wonderful expression. It implies that life was a struggle, but the struggle was worth it, and that this person engaged in the struggle to the end. "He fought the good fight."

This expression comes from the Second Letter to Timothy, where it is heard today in a slightly different form: "I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith." To be able to say that is a great testimony. "I have fought the good fight."

It means that faith is a struggle, but worth it. It means we have faced opposition. We may not have won the race, but we finished it.

When we persevere in our struggles, it does not go unnoticed. Even if we never achieve all our goals, we have achieved the struggle, and that brings its own reward. It may not feel as satisfying, but it impresses a lot of other people. And it pleases God.
