2 Tesalonicenses 1: 11—2: 2

CONTROL DE RUMOR

Los rumores son muy difíciles de controlar. Una vez que salen, crean su propia verdad. Incluso si no son ciertas, crean una sospecha que permanece. No es justo.

Con una comunicación rápida, los rumores pueden ser desafiados y falsificados más rápidamente. Pero también vuelan más rápido. Y pueden hacer un mundo de daños.

En los días de San Pablo, los rumores viajaban más lentamente, pero también las aclaraciones. Fue muy difícil transmitir el mensaje correcto. Esto fue especialmente desafiante para los matices que Paul estaba tratando de hacer.

Por ejemplo, él creía que Jesús regresaría muy pronto, y las personas deberían comportarse en consecuencia. Pero Jesús aún no había venido. Paul lo habría sabido.

En su Segunda Carta a los Tesalonicenses, Pablo trata de sofocar un rumor de que Cristo había venido, mientras promueve la idea de que todavía vendría. "Les pedimos, hermanos y hermanas, con respecto a la venida de nuestro Señor Jesucristo y nuestra reunión con él, que no se salgan de sus mentes repentinamente, ni que se alarmen por un 'espíritu' o por un discurso oral. declaración, o por una carta supuestamente de nosotros en el sentido de que el día del Señor está cerca".

Algunas personas creerán cualquier cosa sobre la venida de Cristo. Nosotros creemos a Paul. Puede que Cristo no haya venido hoy, pero vivimos como si lo hiciera.

Sunday's Reflections

2 Thessalonians 1:11—2:2

RUMOR CONTROL

Rumors are very hard to control. Once they are out they create their own truth. Even if they are not true, they create a suspicion that remains. It is not fair.

With speedy communication, rumors can be challenged and falsified more quickly. But they also fly faster. And they can do a world of damage.

In the days of St. Paul, rumors traveled more slowly, but so did clarifications. It was very hard to get the right message out. This was especially challenging for the nuances Paul was trying to make.

For example, he believed that Jesus was coming back very soon, and people should behave accordingly. But Jesus had not yet come. Paul would have known about that.

In his Second Letter to the Thessalonians, Paul tries to put down a rumor that Christ had come, while promoting the idea that he was still coming. "We ask you, brothers and sisters, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our assembling with him, not to be shaken out of your minds suddenly, or to be alarmed either by a 'spirit,' or by an oral statement, or by a letter allegedly from us to the effect that the day of the Lord is at hand."

Some people will believe anything about the coming of Christ. We believe Paul. Christ may not have come today, but we live as if he will.
