Reflexiones del domingo
2 Tesalonicenses 2:16—3:5
PABLO SÓLIDO DE ROCA

San Pablo parece invencible. Es autor de una serie de cartas de gran importancia para el cristianismo. Dedicó toda su vida al evangelio. Viajó en medio de grandes dificultades, soportó naufragios y encarcelamientos, y debatió la verdad con amigos y enemigos por igual. A lo largo de todo, parecía que nada podría detenerlo.

Todos conocemos gente así. Son grandes líderes, comprometidos con una causa, que perseveran durante los obstáculos naturales y humanos para obtener el premio que buscan. Sólidos como una roca, invitan a la admiración.

San Pablo era así. Pero ocasionalmente, vemos a un Paul diferente, un Paul más humano, uno que necesitaba ayuda para mantener el rumbo. La segunda carta a los tesalonicenses proviene de Pablo y algunos de sus compañeros. Tuvieron éxito en Tesalónica, y esperaban que se repita en otro lugar. Pero había obstáculos. "Hermanos y hermanas, rueguen por nosotros, para que la palabra del Señor pueda avanzar y ser glorificada, como lo hizo entre ustedes, y para que seamos liberados de personas perversas y malvadas, porque no todos tienen fe".

"No todos tienen fe". En esas pocas palabras se esconde un mundo de tristeza, desilusión y dolor. No todos tienen fe. No todos creen como nosotros, y a veces es difícil perseverar. Paul parecía invencible, pero solo porque confiaba en la ayuda de otros, que rezaban por él en su angustia.

Sunday's Reflections
2 Thessalonians 2:16—3:5
ROCK SOLID PAUL

St. Paul seems invincible. He authored a series of letters of towering importance for Christianity. He devoted his entire life to the gospel. He traveled amid great hardship, endured shipwreck and imprisonment, and debated the truth with friend and foe alike. Throughout it all, it seemed as though nothing could stop him.

We all know people like that. They are great leaders, committed to a cause, who persevere during natural and human obstacles to obtain the prize they seek. Solid as a rock, they invite admiration.

St. Paul was like that. But occasionally, we see a different Paul, a more human Paul, one who needed help to stay the course. The Second Letter to the Thessalonians comes from Paul and some of his companions. They had success in Thessalonica, and they hoped it would repeat elsewhere. But there were obstacles. "Brothers and sisters, pray for us, so that the word of the Lord may speed forward and be glorified, as it did among you, and that we may be delivered from perverse and wicked people, for not all have faith."

"Not all have faith." In those few words hide a world of sorrow, disappointment, and pain. Not all have faith. Not everyone believes as we do, and it is sometimes hard to persevere. Paul seemed invincible, but only because he relied on the help of others, who prayed for him in his distress.
