Reflexiones del domingo
Hechos 10: 34-38
NUEVO COMIENZO

Algo sucedió en el bautismo de Jesús. John había estado usando el bautismo como una forma de llevar a las personas a una nueva forma de vida. Rechazaron un nuevo camino en el viaje de la vida y se pusieron completamente al servicio de Dios.

Cuando Jesús aceptó el bautismo de Juan, comenzó su ministerio público. Él hizo maravillas. Él predicó sobre el reino de Dios. Adquirió discípulos. Él predijo su muerte y resurrección. Él rezo. Vivía solo para Dios. Cuando los evangelistas buscaron cómo comenzó este ministerio, todos volvieron al mismo momento: el bautismo de Juan.

En Hechos de los Apóstoles, Pedro fue a la casa de Cornelio el Gentil, porque Cornelio quería saber más acerca de Jesús. Pedro comenzó a enseñar resumiendo la vida de Jesús. Lo hizo de la misma manera que lo hicieron los evangelistas: Dios proclamó la paz, "comenzando en Galilea después del bautismo que Juan predicó", donde "Dios ungió a Jesús de Nazaret con el Espíritu Santo y el poder".

Muchos de nosotros también podemos señalar un momento en que algo sucedió en nuestras vidas. Quizás hubo un día en que comenzamos a mirar el mundo de manera muy diferente. Vimos más claramente quiénes éramos y lo que Dios quería que fuéramos. Nos comprometimos a ser fieles al Dios que nos ama, y desde entonces, nos hemos esforzado por vivir nuestro compromiso. Nadie lo hizo tan perfectamente como Jesús, pero todos somos llamados por Dios para algún propósito.

Sunday's Reflections
Acts 10:34-38
NEW BEGINNING

Something happened at the baptism of Jesus. John had been using baptism as a way of ushering people into a new way of life. They turned down a new path on life's journey and placed themselves completely at the service of God.

When Jesus accepted baptism by John, his public ministry began. He worked wonders. He preached about the reign of God. He acquired disciples. He foretold his death and resurrection. He prayed. He lived for God alone. When the evangelists searched out how this ministry began, they all turned back to the same moment: the baptism by John.

In Acts of the Apostles, Peter went to the house of Cornelius the Gentile, because Cornelius wanted to know more about Jesus. Peter began teaching by summarizing the life of Jesus. He did it the same way the evangelists did: God proclaimed peace, "beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached," where "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power."

Many of us can point to a moment when something happened in our lives, too. Perhaps there was one day when we started looking at the world a lot differently. We saw more clearly who we were and what God wanted us to be. We pledged to be faithful to the God who loves us, and ever since, we have striven to live out our commitment. No one did it as perfectly as Jesus, but we are all called by God for some purpose.
