Reflexiones del domingo
1 Corintios 1: 10-13, 17
DIVISIONES EN LA COMUNIDAD

Las divisiones pueden aparecer en cualquier comunidad de la iglesia. Son signos del pecado que nos esforzamos por vencer. Las personas discuten sobre la misa, se quejan de la predicación, desafían al liderazgo, se enojan con el personal, desprecian la música, se burlan de los niños de la escuela, se encogen de los bebés y se ríen de los ancianos. Las comunidades de la iglesia pueden estar tan distraídas por las personas que ven que descuidan a las personas que no ven: los pobres, los no creyentes, los confinados a su hogar, aquellos que necesitan escuchar el mensaje de Cristo, pero que no lo hacen porque los cristianos están demasiado ocupados quejándose el uno del otro.

En el primer siglo, Corinto, los cristianos estaban haciendo divisiones en la línea de los ministros que los bautizaron. "Pertenezco a Paul", dice uno. "Pertenezco a Apolos", dice otro. "Pertenezco a Cephas", dice otro más. ¿No pertenecemos todos a Cristo? Pero aún escuchará voces de división: "Voy a la misa de las 9:00". "Canto con el coro de adultos". "Mis hijos van a la escuela católica". Es como si los que adoran, cantan o se divierten. educados en otro lugar pertenecen a una familia completamente diferente.

Pablo instó a los corintios a no tener divisiones. Deseaba que se unieran en la misma mente y con el mismo propósito.

Cuando las iglesias se dividen, a menudo significa que los miembros también tienen privilegios: privilegiados de no ver las cargas de los necesitados, privilegiados de exigir que las cosas sigan su camino, privilegiados de pensar que los problemas locales merecen más atención que los globales. Pablo nos llama a una mente y un propósito.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17
DIVISIONS IN THE COMMUNITY

Divisions may show up in any church community. They are signs of the sin we strive to overcome. People argue about the Mass, complain about the preaching, challenge the leadership, get angry at the staff, look down on the music, sneer at the school kids, cringe at infants, and laugh at the elderly. Church communities may be so distracted by the people they see that they neglect the people they do not see: the poor, the unchurched, the homebound—those who need to hear the message of Christ, but who do not because Christians are too busy complaining about one another.

In first century, Corinth, Christians were making divisions along the lines of the ministers who baptized them. "I belong to Paul," says one. "I belong to Apollos," says another. "I belong to Cephas," says still another. Um, don't we all belong to Christ? But you will still hear voices of division: "I go to the 9:00 Mass." "I sing with the adult choir." "My kids go to Catholic school." It is as if those who worship, sing, or get educated elsewhere belong to an entirely different family.

Paul urged the Corinthians to have no divisions. He wished them to be united in the same mind and in the same purpose.

When churches are divided, it often means that members are also privileged: privileged not to see the burdens of the needy, privileged to demand that things go their way, privileged to think that local problems merit more attention than global ones. Paul calls us to one mind and one purpose.
