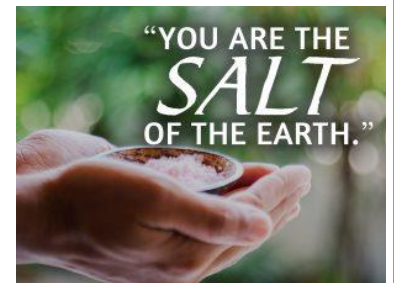

Reflexiones del domingo
Hebreos 2: 14-18
LAS PALABRAS CORRECTAS

Es difícil decir lo correcto en el momento correcto. Algunas personas parecen tener un don para las palabras. Saben qué decir para consolar, desafiar o inspirar a otros. Otros de nosotros decimos cosas sin pensar, palabras que luego lamentamos. A menudo, simplemente no podemos pensar en el argumento que nos gustaría hacer cuando alguien más está hablando. Lo pensamos más tarde. Cuando tenemos la oportunidad de hablar, podemos sentirnos frustrados o inadecuados. Podríamos desear que alguien más hablara en su lugar.

Pero las palabras no lo son todo. La gente también aprende de nosotros por nuestras acciones. A veces, nuestro cuidado y preocupación se escribe en nuestras caras o se comunica en gestos de amabilidad. Dios puede usarlos, incluso cuando no podemos encontrar palabras.

San Pablo escribió a los corintios: "Mi mensaje y mi proclamación no fueron con palabras persuasivas de sabiduría, sino con una demostración de Espíritu y poder". Pablo no confió en la técnica de hablar en público. Él habló sobre su experiencia de Dios, y el poder del Espíritu vino a través de sus palabras con una convicción que impresionó a sus oyentes.

Si nos metemos en situaciones en las que no sabemos qué decir, es posible que deseemos pedirle ayuda a Dios antes de hablar. Cuando abrimos la boca, el Espíritu de Dios puede trabajar, usando nuestra propia experiencia y convicción de una manera que las palabras por sí solas no podrían hacer.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Corinthians 2:1-5
THE RIGHT WORDS

It is hard to say the right thing at the right time. Some people seem to have a gift for words. They know what to say to comfort, challenge, or inspire others. Others of us say things without thinking, words we later regret. Often, we just cannot think of the argument we would like to make when someone else is speaking. We think it up later. When we have the opportunity to speak, we might feel frustrated or inadequate. We might wish someone else would speak instead.

But words are not everything. People also learn from us by our actions. Sometimes our care and concern is written on our faces or communicated in gestures of kindness. God can use us, even when we cannot find words.

St. Paul wrote to the Corinthians, "My message and my proclamation were not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a demonstration of Spirit and power." Paul did not rely on public speaking technique. He spoke about his experience of God, and the power of the Spirit came through his words with a conviction that impressed his hearers.

If we get into situations where we do not know what to say, we may want to ask God for help before we speak. When we open our mouths, the Spirit of God can work, using our own experience and conviction in ways that words alone could not do.
