*1 Corintios 2: 6-10*
**CONSEJO EXPERTO**

Un experto puede resolver rápidamente problemas que puede pasar horas tratando de resolver. Si no puede hacer que el software funcione en su computadora, por ejemplo, puede perder mucho tiempo tratando de descubrir qué está mal. Pero alguien que conoce el software puede arreglarlo en un instante. Lo mismo ocurre con las crisis cotidianas, desde la reparación de automóviles hasta la plomería. Los expertos parecen tener un tipo diferente de sabiduría. Somos bendecidos cuando lo comparten.

Todos tenemos algo de sabiduría que también podemos compartir. Otras personas necesitan nuestra experiencia, consejos y amor. Cada uno de nosotros ha resuelto algunos de los problemas de la vida de una manera que ayudaría a otros a saber.

Es lo más cierto de Dios. Dios tiene una sabiduría más allá de lo que hemos aprendido. Los enigmas de la vida no pueden resolverse con nuestra propia experiencia o razón. Algunas cosas las entregamos al creador de la vida, confiando en el plan divino.

**Sunday's Reflections**
*1 Corinthians 2:6-10*
**EXPERT ADVICE**

An expert can quickly solve problems you may spend hours trying to figure out. If you cannot get the software to work on your computer, for example, you might waste a lot of time trying to figure out what is wrong. But someone who knows the software can fix it up in a snap. The same is true of everyday crises from car repair to plumbing. Experts seem to have a different kind of wisdom. We are blessed when they share it.

We each have some wisdom we can share, too. Other people need our experience, advice, and love. Each of us has solved some of life's problems in a way that would help some others to know.

It is most true of God. God has a wisdom beyond what we have learned. The puzzles of life cannot be solved by our own experience or reason. Some things we turn over to the maker of life, trusting in the divine plan.

Paul tells the Corinthians, "We speak God's wisdom, mysterious, hidden, which God predetermined before the ages for our glory." God has prepared things for us that we cannot experience now. Our sight and hearing help us appreciate the world around us, but in the end they will fail. God's goodness is beyond what we can imagine.

When we need an expert, someone to help us solve the puzzles of life, we turn ourselves over to the wisdom of God.
