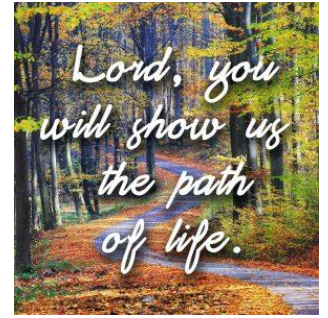

Reflexiones del domingo
1 Pedro 1:17-21
AMIGOS SIN PRECIO

Algunas cosas realmente no tienen precio. Puede pagar una gran parte de sus ingresos duramente ganados para tener una casa, amueblarla para su comodidad, alimentar a las personas que viven allí y disfrutar de las comodidades de la vida. Sabes el costo de las cosas que tienes.

Pero algunas cosas no tienen precio: los niños que juegan, las personas que te aman, las experiencias de amistad, la maravilla de la creación, el aire fresco, la libertad y la fe.

En Semana Santa se hace evidente que algo más no tiene precio. Estamos. Jesús se ofreció a la muerte por algo que no tenía precio para él. La primera carta de Pedro dice: "Fuiste rescatado de tu conducta inútil ... no con cosas perecederas como plata u oro, sino con la preciosa sangre de Cristo". La propia vida de Jesús era más preciosa que la plata y el oro, y la abandonó por lo que valoraba: la humanidad.

En Pascua aprendemos nuevamente cuán preciosa es la vida humana. Llegamos a una nueva comprensión de quiénes somos y cuánto significamos para el Dios que nos hizo. Somos amados.

Cuando miramos a otras personas, vemos a algunos que conocemos bien y otros que son extraños. Vemos personas que amamos y personas que ignoramos. Vemos personas necesitadas y personas de abundancia. Pero si los vemos como Dios los ve, vemos personas de valor. Vivamos en reverencia por la vida que tenemos y la vida que vemos. No tiene precio.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Peter 1:17-21
PRICELESS FRIENDS

Some things truly are priceless. You may pay a lot of your hard-earned income to have a home, furnish it for comfort, feed the people who live there, and enjoy the amenities of life. You know the cost of the things you own.

But some things are priceless—the children who play, the people who love you, experiences of friendship, the wonder of creation, fresh air, freedom, and faith.

At Easter it becomes evident that something else is priceless. We are. Jesus offered himself up to death for something that was priceless to him. The First Letter of Peter says, "You were ransomed from your futile conduct ... not with perishable things like silver or gold but with the precious blood of Christ." Jesus' own life was more precious than silver and gold, and he gave it up for what he valued: humanity.

At Easter we learn again how precious is human life. We come to a new realization of who we are and how much we mean to the God who made us. We are loved.

As we look around at other people, we see some we know well and some who are strangers. We see people we love and people we ignore. We see people in need and people of plenty. But if we see them as God sees them, we see people of value. Let us live in reverence of the life we have and the life we see. It is priceless.
