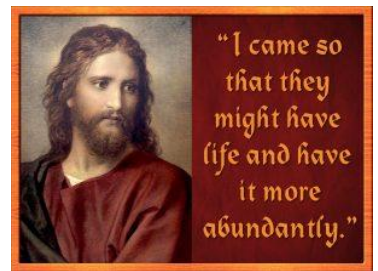

Reflexiones del domingo
1 Pedro 2:20b-25
HACER BIEN, SENTIRSE BIEN

Hacer lo correcto no siempre se siente bien. Podrías defender lo que crees. O te esfuerzas por ayudar a alguien que lo necesita. Pero incluso en estas circunstancias, algo puede salir mal. Otros no aprecian tu sacrificio. Sufres el ridículo. Experimentas pérdida. Sabes que es correcto hacer el bien, pero injustamente no siempre te sientes bien.

La primera carta de Pedro dice: “Si eres paciente cuando sufres por hacer lo que es bueno, esta es una gracia ante Dios. Para esto has sido llamado”.

El bien que hacemos ya es una señal de nuestro progreso en la vida espiritual, incluso si no se siente así. En el pasado, podríamos haber evitado lo que es bueno si parecía amenazar la paz. Podríamos haber guardado silencio sobre la injusticia en el lugar de trabajo, las ofensas de un vecino o lo inapropiado del humor burlón. Nuestro silencio dio su consentimiento. Éramos como ovejas extraviadas.

Pero en Cristo lo sabemos mejor. Hacemos lo correcto incluso si es impopular. Hablamos por los oprimidos. Nos tomamos el tiempo para defender los derechos humanos. Actuamos con audacia que no conocíamos antes. Obtenemos esta fuerza para hacer el bien del Pastor de ovejas, que guía y protege al rebaño.

La fe en Cristo trae consuelo y coraje. Nos hace sentir amados, seguros y fuertes para sufrir por hacer lo que es bueno, incluso cuando no es popular.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Peter 2:20b-25
DOING GOOD, FEELING GOOD

Doing the right thing does not always feel good. You might take a stand for what you believe. Or you go out of your way to assist someone in need. But even in these circumstances, something can still go wrong. Others do not appreciate your sacrifice. You suffer ridicule. You experience loss. You know it is right to do good, but unfairly you do not always feel good.

The First Letter of Peter says, “If you are patient when you suffer for doing what is good, this is a grace before God. For to this you have been called.”

The good we do is already a sign of our progress in the spiritual life, even if it does not feel that way. In the past, we may have avoided what is good if it seemed to threaten peace. We might have kept quiet about injustice in the workplace, the offenses of a neighbor, or the inappropriateness of derisive humor. Our silence gave consent. We were like sheep going astray.

But in Christ we know better. We do what is right even if it is unpopular. We speak up for the oppressed. We take time to defend human rights. We act with boldness we did not know before. We obtain this strength for doing good from the Shepherd of sheep, who guides and protects the flock.

Faith in Christ brings comfort and courage. It makes us feel loved, confident, and strong to suffer for doing what is good, even when it is unpopular.
