Reflexiones del domingo
1 Pedro 2:4-9
PIEDRAS QUE VIVEN

Un buen artista puede tomar algo que otras personas pasan por alto y hacerlo hermoso: una hoja, un guijarro, o incluso un rasguño o un rasguño. Un artista sabe cómo configurar algo simple en un entorno donde brilla su belleza interior.

Dios es el último artista. Dios puede tomarnos a cada uno de nosotros, no importa cuán hermosos o feos seamos afuera o adentro y convertirnos en una visión de gloria.

La primera carta de Pedro nos llama piedras, material que puede pasarse por alto o usarse para construir. Jesús fue una piedra viva que muchas personas rechazaron. Pero Dios el artista encontró lo que era precioso en Jesús la piedra. La carta dice: "como piedras vivas, dejémonos construir en una casa espiritual para ser un santo sacerdocio para ofrecer sacrificios espirituales". Si venimos a Cristo, la piedra viva, él nos convertirá en algo notable.

Otras personas pueden no apreciar nuestra belleza interior. Es posible que no se den cuenta de los regalos que tenemos. Puede que no sepan cómo podemos honrar sus vidas. Incluso pueden hacernos sentir inútiles.

Pero Dios nos encuentra más útiles. Somos piedras vivas, agradables a Dios por medio de Jesucristo.

Algunas personas pasan por alto lo que los buenos cristianos piensan y hacen. Construyen arsenales en lugar de alimentar a los hambrientos. Cortan relaciones en lugar de otorgar perdón. Malgastan el tiempo en lugar de usarlo para el bien. Pero Dios aprecia el bien que hacemos y nos edifica como piedras vivas.

Sunday's Reflections
1 Peter 2:4-9
STONES THAT LIVE

A good artist can take something other people overlook and make it beautiful—a leaf, a pebble, or even a scuff or a scratch. An artist knows how to set something simple in an environment where its inner beauty shines.

God is the ultimate artist. God can take each of us, no matter how beautiful or ugly we are outside or inside and turn us into a vision of glory.

The First Letter of Peter calls us stones, material that can be overlooked or used for building. Jesus was a living stone that many people rejected. But God the artist found what was precious in Jesus the stone. The letter says, "like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices." If we come to Christ, the living stone, he will fashion us into something remarkable.

Other people may not appreciate our inner beauty. They may not notice the gifts we have. They may not know how we can grace their lives. They may even make us feel useless.

But God finds us most useful. We are living stones, pleasing to God through Jesus Christ.

Some people overlook what good Christians think and do. They build arsenals rather than feed the hungry. They sever relationships rather than grant forgiveness. They squander time rather than use it for the good. But God appreciates the good we do and builds us up as living stones.
