Reflexiones del domingo
Romanos 8:22-27
SIN PALABRAS

A veces es difícil saber qué decir. Incluso cuando estás con personas que te gustan, puede llegar un punto en el que la conversación se detenga. Quizás estés cansado. Quizás quieras decir algo pero no sabes cómo. O te has quedado sin cosas que decir por ahora.

Pero en cierto modo, la conversación nunca se detiene. Ustedes están el uno con el otro. Ustedes pasan tiempo juntos. En algún nivel te estás comunicando. Expresas la comodidad que tienes al estar juntos, en un momento en que las palabras no son realmente necesarias.

El tiempo que pasamos en oración con Dios también puede ser así. Especialmente cuando nos reunimos los domingos, usamos muchas palabras cuando oramos. Pero también es posible orar en silencio, simplemente pasar tiempo con Dios cuando estamos demasiado cansados, cuando no sabemos cómo expresar nuestros pensamientos o cuando no tenemos nada especial que decir. Dios es un querido compañero con quien las palabras no son realmente necesarias.

Pablo escribe a los romanos: "El Espíritu también viene en ayuda de nuestra debilidad; porque no sabemos orar como deberíamos, pero el Espíritu mismo intercede con gemidos inexpressables".

Cuando pasamos tiempo en silencio ante Dios, es el Espíritu quien ora a través de nosotros, el Espíritu que llena la iglesia este Pentecostés. Dios conoce las intenciones del Espíritu, y eso hace que nuestra oración sea completa.

Sunday's Reflections
Romans 8:22-27
SPEECHLESS

Sometimes it is hard to know what to say. Even when you are with people you like, there may come a point where the conversation stops. Perhaps you are tired. Perhaps you want to say something but do not know how. Or you have run out of things to say for now.

But in a way, the conversation never stops. You are with each other. You are spending time together. On some level you are communicating. You express the comfort you have just being together, at a time when words are not really necessary.

The time we spend in prayer with God can be like that too. Especially when we gather on Sundays, we use a lot of words when we pray. But it is also possible to pray in silence, simply to spend time with God when we are too tired, when we do not know how to express our thoughts, or when we have nothing special to say. God is a dear companion with whom words are not really necessary.

Paul writes to the Romans, "The Spirit too comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings."

When we spend time in silence before God, it is the Spirit who prays through us, the Spirit who fills the church this Pentecost. God knows the intentions of the Spirit, and that makes our prayer complete.
