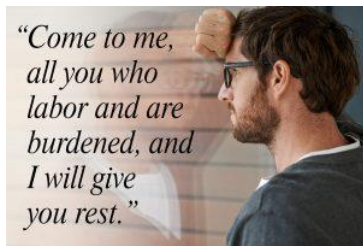

Romanos 8:9, 11-13
SIGUIENDO LAS REGLAS

¿Con qué reglas vives? Usted observa las leyes de la iglesia y el estado. Cumple con las expectativas de su familia. Sigue los procedimientos en el lugar de trabajo. Si te esfuerzas por vivir fiel a Dios, a la sociedad y a ti mismo, sigues algunas buenas reglas interiores.

Pero a veces vivimos con reglas de hábito. Hacemos cosas porque siempre las hemos hecho. En sí mismo, eso no es malo. Pero a veces las circunstancias cambian. Las reglas que aplica al hijo mayor pueden doblarse cuando el más pequeño sea mayor de edad. Los procedimientos que sigue en el trabajo pueden dejarse de lado para ayudar a alguien que lo necesite. Las reglas son buenas. Ayudan a la sociedad a vivir en paz. Pero si las reglas se convierten en tiranos, frustran el mismo orden que pretenden preservar.

San Pablo advierte a los romanos: "No estás en la carne; por el contrario, estás en el espíritu, si solo el Espíritu de Dios habita en ti".

En el pasado, los romanos habían vivido según la ley de la carne. Hicieron lo que pudieron escapar. Observaron reglas por el bien de la supervivencia. Pero ahora son cristianos. El Espíritu de Dios habita dentro de ellos. Viven ahora por la ley del amor. Toman decisiones de manera diferente, pensando en los demás, no solo en ellos mismos.

Las reglas por las que vivimos merecen ser seguidas especialmente cuando expresan los deseos del Espíritu Santo de Dios. El Espíritu de amor presenta la ley suprema. Como cristianos, agradamos a Dios cuando obedecemos al Espíritu de Cristo.

Sunday's Reflections
Romans 8:9, 11-13
FOLLOWING THE RULES

What rules do you live by? You observe the laws of church and state. You fulfill the expectations of your family. You follow procedures at the workplace. If you strive to live faithful to God, society and yourself, you follow some good interior rules.

But sometimes we live by rules of habit. We do things because we have always done them. In itself, that is not bad. But sometimes circumstances change. The rules you apply to the oldest child might bend when the youngest comes of age. Procedures you follow at work might be put aside to help someone in need. Rules are good. They help society live in peace. But if the rules become tyrants, they thwart the very order they aim to preserve.

St. Paul cautions the Romans, "You are not in the flesh; on the contrary, you are in the spirit, if only the Spirit of God dwells in you."

In the past, the Romans had lived according to the law of the flesh. They did what they could get away with. They observed rules for the sake of survival. But now they are Christians. The Spirit of God dwells within them. They live now by the law of love. They make decisions differently, thinking of others, not just of themselves.

The rules we live by deserve to be followed especially as they express the desires of God's Holy Spirit. The Spirit of love presents the supreme law. As Christians, we please God when we obey the Spirit of Christ.
