Romanos 8:18-23
NADA DE SUFRIMIENTO

Cuanto más envejecemos, más gemimos. Dolor muscular La memoria se desvanece. Las papilas gustativas fallan. La audición disminuye. La vista se oscurece. Estatura se dobla. Nuestra salud física decae y el sufrimiento se intensifica. Envejecer, como dicen, no es para los débiles.

Para muchas personas, el envejecimiento puede ser motivo de desesperación. Pero para los cristianos, es solo otro aspecto de las imperfecciones de la vida. Nos hemos acostumbrado a las decepciones de esta vida. No son nada comparados con la promesa de salvación. Soportamos los inconvenientes que experimentamos porque creemos en la alegría que nos espera.

San Pablo escribe a los romanos: "Considero que los sufrimientos de este tiempo presente no son nada comparados con la gloria que se nos revelará".

Pablo creía en la promesa de Dios, que había más por delante para él después de su muerte. Creía que la promesa se extendía a todos los fieles, y de hecho a toda la creación. La creación misma ha estado gimiendo, esperando una vida más perfecta. La perfección llega a todo el mundo a través de Cristo.

Sunday's Reflections
Romans 8:18-23
SUFFERING NOTHING

The older we get, the more we groan. Muscles ache. Memory fades. Taste buds fail. Hearing diminishes. Eyesight darkens. Stature bends. Our physical health decays, and suffering intensifies. Growing old, as they say, is not for wimps.

For many people, aging might be cause for despair. But for Christians, it is just another aspect of the imperfections of life. We have grown accustomed to the disappointments of this life. They are nothing compared with the promise of salvation. We put up with the inconveniences we experience because we believe in the joy that lies ahead.

St. Paul writes to the Romans, "I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us."

Paul believed in God's promise, that there was more ahead for him after he died. He believed that promise extended to all the faithful, and indeed to all creation. Creation itself has been groaning, awaiting a more perfect life. Perfection comes to all the world through Christ.

We may be growing older, but we are always children—God's children. We may be heading towards death, but we are really heading towards birth—birth to a new kind of life. The sufferings of today are as nothing. We are groaning in expectation of a joy that is to come.
