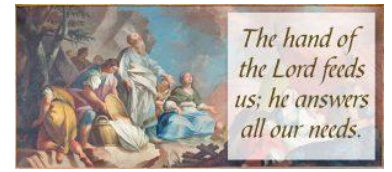

**Reflexiones del domingo**
*Romanos 8:35, 37-39*
**AMOR INFALIBLE**

Se supone que el amor dura para siempre, por lo que es horrible cuando no lo hace. Cuando amamos a alguien, ofrecemos todo lo que tenemos y somos. Damos nuestro tiempo libre, porque el amor disfruta del ocio. Compartimos nuestro dinero, porque el amor no tiene precio. Revelamos nuestros pensamientos más íntimos, porque el amor crece en la intimidad. Asumimos grandes riesgos cuando amamos. Nos arriesgamos a compartir nuestras bondades y defectos. El verdadero amor acepta lo que es imperfecto porque el corazón siempre es bueno.

A veces el amor falla. Dejamos de amar a la persona que amamos, o la persona que amamos deja de amarnos. Las imperfecciones salen a la luz. Las diferencias de opinión no se pueden resolver. Las personas que confunden la calidez del amor con el amor mismo descubren el engaño en la otra persona o en los antojos de su propio corazón. La pérdida del amor es una lección dolorosa de traición, juicio erróneo y tristeza.

No es así con Cristo. Nada puede separarnos del amor de Dios en Cristo Jesús, nuestro Señor. El amor de Dios sigue siendo perfecto y dura para siempre, sin importar dónde se doble nuestro corazón. A veces amamos menos a Dios, pero Dios nunca nos ama menos. El amor de Dios dura para siempre.

**Sunday's Reflections**
*Romans 8:35, 37-39*
**LOVE UNFAILING**

Love is supposed to last forever, so it is horrifying when it does not. When we love someone, we offer all we have and are. We give our free time because love enjoys leisure. We share our money because love is priceless. We reveal our inmost thoughts because love grows in intimacy. We take great risks when we love. We risk sharing our goodness and shortcomings. True love accepts what is imperfect because the heart is always good.

Sometimes love fails. We stop loving the person we loved, or the one we loved stops loving us. Imperfections come to light. Differences of opinion cannot be resolved. People who confused the warmth of love with love itself discover deceit in the other person or in the cravings of their own heart. The loss of love is a painful lesson in betrayal, misjudgment, and sorrow.

The question St. Paul asks the Romans, then, is fraught with risk. "What will separate us from the love of Christ?" Oh, my. Is this possible? We know from experience that love may depart. In human love, many things may cause separation: political opinions, selfish actions, lost opportunities for mutual sharing, or the attraction of another person. Love is strong, but other forces can be stronger.

Not so with Christ. Nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. God's love remains perfect and lasts forever, no matter where our heart bends. We sometimes love God less, but God never loves us less. God's love lasts forever.
