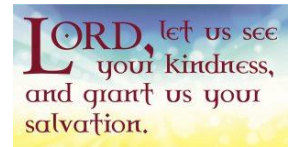

Reflexiones del domingo
Romanos 9:1-5
FE RELATIVA

Cuando alguien que amas está en problemas, deseas su libertad con tanta fuerza que podrías decir: "Con mucho gusto cambiaría de lugar". Por ejemplo, los padres que miran a un niño enfermo en una cama de hospital aceptarían la enfermedad ellos mismos si pudieran, si tan solo liberaran al niño que aman. Tu amor por los afligidos es más fuerte que la fuerza que los deja indefensos.

San Pablo se sentía así por aquellos que no creían en Cristo. Él les dice a los romanos: "Podría desear que yo mismo fuera maldecido y separado de Cristo por el bien de mi propio pueblo, mi parentesco según la carne".

La propia familia de Paul no se había unido a él en fe. Irónicamente, Jesús tuvo la misma familia. A los israelitas pertenecía la adopción, la gloria, los convenios, la ley, el culto y las promesas. Cristo era de ellos, también, según la carne. Pablo lamentó que sus parientes no todos abrazaron a Cristo según el Espíritu. Amaba tanto a estas personas que estaba dispuesto a intercambiar lugares. Los amaba con más fuerza que las fuerzas de la incredulidad.

En nuestra sociedad, muchas personas aún no han aceptado a Cristo. No escuchan su voz en las Escrituras. No experimentan su amor en la comunidad. No alzan sus voces en oración. No se unen a él en la mesa para la Eucaristía. El dolor que sentimos renueva nuestra convicción de proclamar a Cristo.

Sunday's Reflections
Romanos 9:1-5
RELATIVE FAITH

When someone you love is in trouble, you desire their freedom so strongly that you might say, "I would gladly trade places." For example, parents looking at a sick child in a hospital bed would accept the sickness themselves if they could—if only it would free the child they love. Your love for the afflicted is stronger than the force that renders them helpless.

St. Paul felt this way about those not believing in Christ. He says to the Romans, "I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my own people, my kindred according to the flesh."

Paul's own kindred had not all joined him in faith. Ironically, Jesus had the same kindred. To the Israelites belonged the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the law, the worship, and the promises. Christ was theirs, also, according to the flesh. Paul regretted that his relatives did not all embrace Christ according to the Spirit. He loved these people so much that he was willing to trade places. He loved them more strongly than the forces of unbelief.

In our society many people have still not accepted Christ. They do not hear his voice in the Scriptures. They do not experience his love in the community. They do not lift their voices in prayer. They do not join him at table for the Eucharist. The pain we feel renews our conviction to proclaim Christ.
