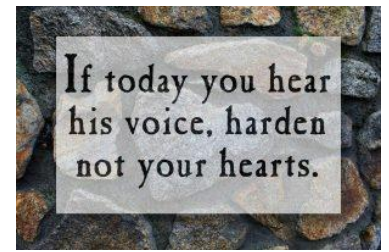

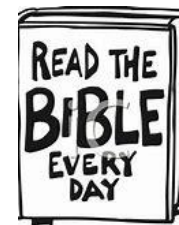

Reflexiones del domingo
Romanos 13:8-10
ESTABLECIENDO LA LEY

A medida que las instituciones envejecen, sus leyes se multiplican. A medida que los países envejecen, las leyes de la nación, el estado y la ciudad se vuelven cada vez más complejas. Es difícil conocerlos a todos. Contratamos abogados para estudiar leyes por nosotros.

Las leyes de la iglesia también son complejas. Están recogidos en el código de derecho canónico, que también es difícil de asimilar. Necesitamos abogados de la iglesia para ayudarnos. Todo el tiempo se escriben nuevas leyes. Los viejos están ajustados. El código se vuelve obsoleto lentamente a medida que se forma una nueva legislación. Todo el mundo quiere ser un buen ciudadano y católico, pero a veces es difícil saber cuál es la ley.

En los días de Jesús, la ley también era compleja. A veces parecía que las leyes entraban en conflicto, como cuando sanó en sábado. Las leyes de la caridad entraron en conflicto con las leyes que rigen el tiempo sagrado.

Cuando le pidieron a Jesús la ley más grande, simplificó la compleja estructura de las leyes y las redujo a dos: Amar a Dios. Ama a tu prójimo.

San Pablo dijo a los romanos: "El que ama a otro ha cumplido la ley". Lo hizo muy simple.

Dios es el juez supremo sobre cómo observamos las leyes de la iglesia y el estado. Dios hizo las reglas lo más simples posible. Cuando las leyes de nuestras instituciones parecen complejas, siempre podemos agradecer a Dios siguiendo la ley más básica de todas: el amor.

Sunday's Reflections
Romanos 13:8-10
LAYING DOWN THE LAW

As institutions age, their laws multiply. As countries grow older, the laws of nation, state, and city grow ever more complex. It is hard to know them all. We hire lawyers to study laws for us.

The laws of the church are also complex. They are collected in the code of canon law, which is also hard to absorb. We need church lawyers to help us out. New laws are written all the time. Old ones are adjusted. The code grows slowly outdated as new legislation forms. Everyone wants to be a good citizen and a good Catholic, but it is hard sometimes to know what the law is.

In Jesus' day, the law was also complex. At times it appeared that laws conflicted, as when he healed on a Sabbath. Laws of charity conflicted with laws governing sacred time.

When they asked Jesus for the greatest law, he simplified the complex structure of laws and reduced them to two: Love God. Love your neighbor.

St. Paul told the Romans, "The one who loves another has fulfilled the law." He made it very simple.

God is the ultimate judge over how we observe the laws of church and state. God made the rules as simple as possible. When the laws of our institutions seem complex, we can always please God by following the most basic law of all: love.
