Romanos 14:7-9
AMADO DEL MAESTRO

Lamentablemente, puede ser necesaria una tragedia para recordarnos que pertenecemos a Dios. Llenamos nuestra vida de actividades. Confiamos en nuestra propia fuerza. Dependemos de otras personas. A veces nos olvidamos del Dios que nos hizo, que nos ama y que algún día nos llamará a casa.

Cuando la vida va bien, pensamos en nosotros mismos como nuestros propios amos. Tenemos libertades y opciones. Tomamos decisiones sobre nuestras familias, nuestro trabajo y nuestro juego.

Pero de vez en cuando, descubrimos que no somos los maestros. No tenemos un control completo sobre nuestra salud. No podemos determinar qué hará otro conductor. No podemos evitar que los enemigos del estado actúen de manera irracional e irreverente. No podemos controlarlo todo.

Sunday's Reflections
Romanos 14:7-9
BELOVED OF THE MASTER

Sadly, it may take a tragedy to remind us that we belong to God. We fill our lives with activities. We rely on our own strength. We depend on other people. We forget sometimes the God who made us, who loves us, and who will one day call us home.

When life is going well, we think of ourselves as our own masters. We have freedoms and choices. We make decisions about our families, our work, and our play.

But every so often, we discover we are not the masters. We do not have complete control over our health. We cannot determine what another driver will do. We cannot stop enemies of the state from acting irrationally and irreverently. We cannot control everything.

St. Paul tells the Romans, "None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. ... whether we live or die, we are the Lord's."

Sometimes this does not sink in until a tragedy touches our lives. When we suddenly realize we are not in control, we wake up to our dependence on God.

God governs creation and redemption and all that lies in the middle. Although we are not masters, we are not slaves either. We are the beloved of God. God does everything for us in love, and all that we do in life is in response to the love we receive.

Yes, we live. Yes, we shall die. Yes, we belong to God.
