Renewal of their commitment will take place within the Mass. Considering the current coronavirus pandemic, social distancing will be practiced, and a couple need not be present to receive a certificate. Those who attend the Mass can pick up their certificates at the Cathedral that day. The certificates of those who do not attend will be sent to the corresponding parish office for distribution. Space is limited. Reserved seating will be available to the jubilarian couples; then, if space is available, family and friends may reserve seats on a first-come, first-serve basis. 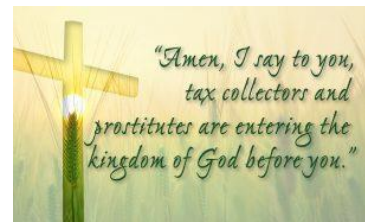

Filipenses 2:1-11
TENER ACTITUD

La unidad trae fuerza. La unidad es el objetivo de cualquier comunidad, ya sea familia, iglesia, empresa o nación. Los miembros del grupo que disfrutan de la compañía del otro atraen a los recién llegados. Estos grupos tienen éxito. Avanzan hacia su objetivo. Generan entusiasmo. Son fuertes.

San Pablo deseaba ese tipo de unidad para los filipenses. Sabía qué los haría fuertes. Deseó que tuvieran la misma mente y el mismo amor. Quería que pensarán en una cosa: "Tengan en ustedes la misma actitud que también hay en Cristo Jesús".

La actitud de Jesús fue de servicio. Jesús consideró humildemente a los demás más que a sí mismo al ofrecer su vida en la cruz. No veía por sus propios intereses, sino por los de los demás. No exigió que la copa del sufrimiento pasara junto a él. Aceptó el dolor para que otros pudieran experimentar gozo.

Los grupos se unen debido a otro rasgo que puede no ser evidente: la humildad. Cada miembro atiende las necesidades de todo el grupo. Cada persona ve por el bien de todos, no solo por su propio bien. Sunday's Reflections
Philippians 2:1-11
HAVING ATTITUDE

Unity brings strength. Unity is the goal of any community, whether it be family, church, business, or nation. Group members who enjoy one another's company appeal to newcomers. These groups succeed. They move toward their goal. They breed excitement. They are strong.

St. Paul wished that kind of unity for the Philippians. He knew what would make them strong. He wished them to have the same mind and the same love. He wanted them thinking about one thing: "Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus."

The attitude of Jesus was service. Jesus humbly regarded others more than himself by offering his life on the cross. He looked out not for his own interests, but for those of others. He did not demand that the cup of suffering pass by him. He accepted sorrow so that others might experience joy.

Groups unite because of another trait that may not be evident: humility. Each member serves the needs of the entire group. Each person looks out for the good of the whole, not just for their own sakes. It may look like good groups are simply having fun, but they also endure hardship. Everyone has the attitude of Christ, and that is what makes groups united and strong.

Some people wish they belonged to a united group. Others make their group united by contributing the strength of humble service.
