*Filipenses 4:6-9*
**PRACTICAR LA PAZ**

La paz puede ser tuya. Es difícil encontrar la paz en una vida ajetreada con muchos compromisos, vecinos ruidosos y calles enojadas. Pero la paz puede ser tuya.

La paz es tan alcanzable como la buena salud y las buenas amistades. Requiere trabajo. Pero hay una fórmula. Si desea una buena salud, desarrolla hábitos de alimentación y ejercicio. Si quieres buenos amigos, trabajas en las relaciones y practicas el altruismo. Estos objetivos requieren trabajo, pero están al alcance.

La paz también. San Pablo aconseja a los filipenses que no tengan ninguna ansiedad y que den a conocer sus necesidades a Dios. "Entonces la paz de Dios, que sobrepasa todo entendimiento, guardará sus corazones y mentes en Cristo Jesús".

Eso es. Deja a un lado la ansiedad y da a conocer tus peticiones a Dios. Si tiene necesidades, no se preocupe por ellas. Dáselas a Dios. Deja que Dios se encargue de eso. Mientras tanto, dice Pablo, piensa en lo que es verdadero, honorable, justo, puro, hermoso, lleno de gracia y excelente, no en lo que te falta. Cuando practicas la paz pensando en cosas pacíficas, la paz puede ser tuya.

**Sunday's Reflections**
*Philippians 4:6-9*
**PRACTICING PEACE**

Peace can be yours. It is hard to find peace in a busy life with many commitments, noisy neighbors, and angry streets. But peace can be yours.

Peace is as attainable as good health and good friendships. It requires work. But there is a formula. If you want good health you develop habits of eating and exercising. If you want good friends you work at relationships and practice selflessness. These goals require work, but they are within reach.

So is peace. St. Paul advises the Philippians to have no anxiety at all and to make their needs known to God. "Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."

That's it. Put anxiety away and make your requests known to God. If you have needs, do not dwell on them. Give them to God. Let God take it from there. Meanwhile, Paul says, think about what is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, gracious, and excellent—not about what you are lacking. When you practice peace by thinking of peaceable things, peace can be yours.

No one decides what goes into your mouth except you. You can diet if you want to. No one decides what friends you have except you. You can make and break relationships. No one decides what goes into your mind except you. You can think about the things that bring peace, and peace can be yours.
