Reflexiones del domingo
Filipenses 4:12-14, 19-20
FUENTE DE FELICIDAD

La felicidad viene solo de Dios. Pero eso no parece impedir que la gente lo persiga de otras formas.

Muchos de nosotros pensamos que la felicidad proviene de tener dinero y gastarlo en posesiones. Las cosas de este mundo nos encantan. Traen alegría a los días tristes. Pero no tienen permanencia y no pueden traer el deleite eterno.

Otros piensan que la felicidad proviene del contacto humano. De hecho, los amigos nos traen felicidad más allá de lo que pueden proporcionar los bienes materiales. Pero algunas personas van de amigo en amigo, de relación en relación, buscando algo más. Los mejores amigos están comprometidos con la amistad y aprenden la naturaleza del amor. Sin embargo, incluso el amor de los amigos no es más que un símbolo del amor de Dios por nosotros. El amor humano participa de la vida divina, pero el amor humano nunca es perfecto.

La verdadera felicidad proviene solo de Dios. San Pablo había vivido en las circunstancias más humildes y había disfrutado de la abundante generosidad de los bienhechores. Les dijo a los filipenses: "En toda circunstancia y en todas las cosas he aprendido el secreto de estar bien alimentado y de pasar hambre ... Todo lo puedo en Aquel que me fortalece".

Todas las cosas: podemos hacer todas las cosas en Dios, quien nos fortalece. Podemos ser ricos o pobres. Podemos estar solos o en medio de otros. Podemos tener hambre o estar muy bien alimentados. Pero solo podemos ser felices en Dios.

Sunday's Reflections
Philippians 4:12-14, 19-20
SOURCE OF HAPPINESS

Happiness comes from God alone. But that does not seem to stop people from pursuing it in other ways.

Many of us think happiness comes from having money and spending it on possessions. The things of this world charm us. They bring joy to dreary days. But they have no permanence, and they cannot bring eternal delight.

Others think happiness comes from human contact. Indeed, friends bring us happiness beyond what material goods can supply. But some people go from friend to friend, from relationship to relationship, seeking something more. The best of friends are committed to friendship, and they learn the nature of love. Yet even the love of friends is but a symbol of God's love for us. Human love shares in divine life, but human love is never perfect.

True happiness comes from God alone. St. Paul had lived in the humblest of circumstances and he had enjoyed the abundant generosity of benefactors. He told the Philippians, "In every circumstance and in all things I have learned the secret of being well fed and of going hungry, ... I can do all things in him who strengthens me."

All things—we can do all things in God who strengthens us. We can be rich or we can be poor. We can be alone or in the midst of others. We can be hungry or very well fed. But we can only be happy in God.
