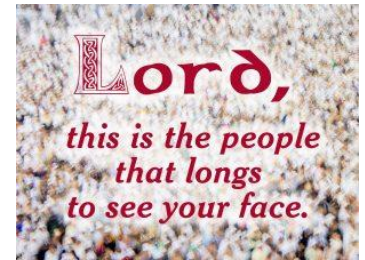

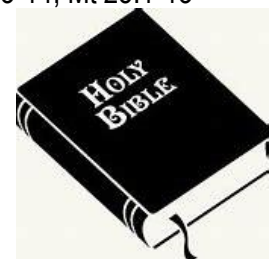

Reflexiones del domingo

1 *Tesalonicenses 2: 7b-9, 13*

EL MINISTRO DEL MENSAJE

El ministro no es lo mismo que el mensaje. Pero el mensaje tendrá poder si el ministro tiene amor.

Pablo, Silvano y Timoteo distinguieron entre el ministro y el mensaje en la Primera Carta a los Tesalonicenses. Cuando visitaron la comunidad por primera vez, eligieron un estilo amable, como una madre lactante que cuida a los niños. Trajeron el evangelio con amor, no con fuerza. "Con tanto afecto por ti, estábamos decididos a compartir contigo no solo el evangelio de Dios, sino también a nosotros mismos".

Los misioneros se sentían muy cercanos a las personas a las que evangelizaban. Compartieron su fe, que era extremadamente importante para ellos, pero también compartieron sus vidas, sus alegrías y tristezas, sus esperanzas y sueños. Todos se hicieron amigos. La comunidad experimentó junta el amor que Jesús había predicado. Los ministros y los que conocieron trabajaron duro juntos. No hicieron el largo viaje para aprovecharse de la población local. En cambio, vinieron en una misión de amor, para predicar sobre el amor y ser amor para sus nuevos amigos.

Dios nos ha confiado a cada uno de nosotros como ministro de la palabra. No somos lo mismo que el mensaje, pero el mensaje será transmitido por nuestra forma de vida. Si vivimos en paz y amistad con los demás, proclamaremos el mensaje del evangelio en más que palabras.

Sunday's Reflections

1 *Thessalonians 2:7b-9, 13*

THE MESSAGE'S MINISTER

The minister is not the same as the message. But the message will have power if the minister has love.

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy distinguished between the minister and the message in the First Letter to the Thessalonians. When they had first visited the community, they chose a gentle style—like a nursing mother caring for children. They brought the gospel in love, not with force. "With such affection for you, we were determined to share with you not only the gospel of God, but our very selves as well."

The missionaries felt very close to the people they evangelized. They shared their faith, which was extremely important to them, but they also shared their lives—their joys and sorrows, their hopes and dreams. They all became friends. The community experienced together the love that Jesus had preached. The ministers and those they met worked hard together. They did not make the long journey in order to take advantage of the local population. Instead, they came on a mission of love, to preach about love and to be love for their new friends.

God has entrusted each of us as a minister of the word. We are not the same as the message, but the message will be conveyed by how we live. If we live in peace and friendship with others, we will proclaim the gospel message in more than words.
