If you were a part of the bible study, please rejoin us. We have plenty of room for social distancing and of course please, wear a mask. We will be discussing Chapter 15, Exile.

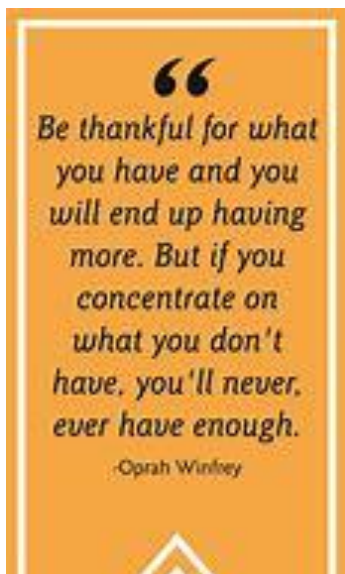

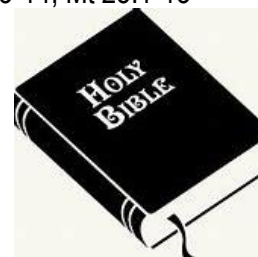

1 Tesalonicenses 4:13-18

EL MINISTRO DEL MENSAJE

Nuestros cementerios contienen los restos de los muertos y nos brindan un lugar para recordar sus vidas. Cuando paseamos por un cementerio, vemos los nombres de muchos que no conocemos. Confiamos en que alguien todavía los conoce, todavía los recuerda y todavía lamenta su fallecimiento. Esperamos que alguien recuerde el bien que hacemos y la vida que llevamos.

En la Primera Carta a los Tesalonicenses, Pablo, Silvano y Timoteo consuelan a un nuevo grupo de cristianos sobre sus muertos. Los tesalonicenses se preguntan si sus muertos estarán perdidos para siempre. Después de todo, Jesús debía regresar pronto. ¿Se lo han perdido? ¿Su fe se ha ido en vano? ¿Están para siempre condenados al sepulcro, sin poder regocijarse en el Día del Señor?

Los misioneros responden que no hay motivo de duelo. "Porque si creemos que Jesús murió y resucitó, así también Dios, por medio de Jesús, traerá consigo a los que durmieron". Los vivos tienen esperanza, y también los muertos.

Sunday's Reflections

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

REMEMBERING THE DEAD

Our cemeteries contain the remains of the dead and give us a place to remember their lives. We all strive to live a life worth remembering, a life that has purpose. Some lives are shorter than others, but all lives have meaning, and each person is loved by God.

When we stroll through a cemetery, we see the names of many we do not know. We trust that someone still knows them, still remembers them, and still grieves their passing. We hope someone will remember the good we do and the life we lead.

In the First Letter to the Thessalonians, Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy console a new group of Christians about their dead. The Thessalonians wonder if their dead are lost forever. After all, Jesus was due to return shortly. Have they missed out? Has their belief gone for no good? Are they forever consigned to the grave, unable to rejoice in the Day of the Lord?

The missionaries answer that there is no cause to grieve. "For if we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God, through Jesus, bring with him those who have fallen asleep." The living have hope, and so do the dead.

Our cemeteries are reminders of the dead, and they are beacons of hope for the living. For no matter how long or short our lives, how many people we met, or who has remembered or forgotten our names, there is One who always remembers, who has the power to raise us to a new hope, a new life.
