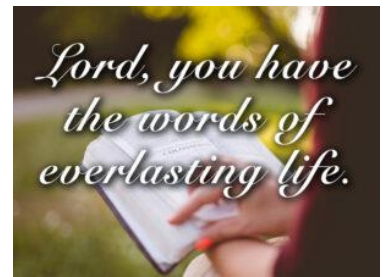

Efesias 5:8-14
SER SONÁMBULO

El sueño es hermoso cuando llega en el momento adecuado, pero vergonzoso de lo contrario. Algunas personas duermen durante la clase. Duermen en las reuniones. Duermen durante los conciertos. Tienen buenas intenciones, pero se pierden momentos importantes de la vida.

Otras personas duermen toda la vida de otras formas. No son conscientes de los problemas políticos, no se preocupan por las necesidades de los pobres, ignoran los modales, se mantienen alejados de las personas que buscan su atención. Algunas personas duermen por la vida, por las relaciones y por la fe.

En todo el mundo, muchas personas desconocen a Cristo. Es como si estuvieran dormidos. Viven en una oscuridad fuera de la luz de las buenas nuevas. Pueden tener un sentido interior de bondad, dado como un regalo de Dios. Pero es posible que aún no hayan escuchado el evangelio o no hayan tenido la oportunidad de vivirlo con fe.

A través del bautismo, se nos ha despertado de nuestro sueño. Cristo es nuestra luz. La Carta a los Efesios dice: "Hermanos y hermanas: antes eran tinieblas, pero ahora son luz en el Señor". El bautismo ha cambiado nuestro estado. Ya no pertenecemos a la noche. Brillamos con la luz del día.

Sunday's Reflections
Ephesians 5:8-14
SLEEPWALK

Sleep is beautiful when it comes at the right time but embarrassing otherwise. Some people sleep through class. They sleep at meetings. They sleep during concerts. They mean well, but they miss out on important moments of life.

Other people sleep through life in other ways. They are unaware of political issues, unconcerned for the needs of the poor, ignorant of manners, aloof from people seeking their attention. Some people sleep through life, through relationships and through faith.

Around the world, many people are unaware of Christ. It is as if they are asleep. They live in a darkness outside the light of the good news. They may have some inner sense of goodness, given as a gift from God. But they may not yet have heard the gospel or had the opportunity to live it in faith.

Through baptism, we have been awakened from our sleep. Christ is our light. The Letter to the Ephesians says, "Brothers and sisters: You were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord." Baptism has changed our status. We no longer belong to the night. We shine with the light of day.

But this has consequences: "Live as children of light." Having moved from darkness to light, we now have responsibilities. Let us shake off the sleep that threatens to keep us from being faithful to Christ. Throughout this Lent, let us rise from sleep- and live-in light.
