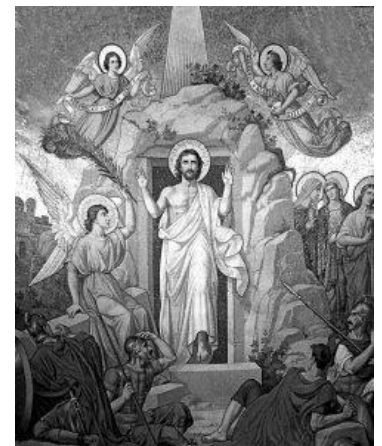

Reflexiones del domingo

1 Corintios 5: 6b-8

AFUERA CON LO VIEJO

Si hizo una buena Cuaresma, sacrificó algunas cosas de las que probablemente necesitaba prescindir. Ahora la Pascua está aquí. ¿Vuelve a sus viejos hábitos? ¿O ha hecho algunos cambios para bien?

Si eliminó algunos malos hábitos, déjelos ir. ¡Te sentirás tentado a traerlos de vuelta o reemplazarlos por otros! Es mejor reemplazar los malos hábitos con hábitos de caridad, o con nada en absoluto.

Pablo usa la imagen de la levadura para aclarar este punto cuando escribe a los Corintios. A menudo pensamos en la levadura como algo bueno que ayuda a que una buena barra de pan crezca. Pero lo imagina como otra cosa: una impureza que se interpone en el camino de una buena y abundante pan sin tostar.

Si la levadura se ha echado a perder, la reemplazamos con levadura que sea buena. Pero para Paul, la levadura nunca fue buena para empezar. Entonces, si está malo, deshágase de él y hornee sin él. Él escribe: "Limpia la levadura vieja, para que puedas convertirte en una nueva tanda de masa, en tanto que eres sin levadura". Continúa: "Celebremos la fiesta, no con la levadura vieja, la levadura de la malicia y la maldad, sino con el pan sin levadura de la sinceridad y la verdad".

Por lo tanto, abandone esos malos hábitos de malicia y maldad previos a la Cuaresma. Y celebre la Pascua de la forma en que Dios la hizo: ¡con sinceridad y verdad! ¡Felices Pascuas!

Sunday's Reflections

1 Corinthians 5:6b-8

OUT WITH THE OLD

If you made a good Lent, you sacrificed some things you probably needed to do without. Now Easter is here. Do you go back to your old habits? Or have you made some changes for the good?

If you eliminated some bad habits, let them go. You will be tempted to bring them back or to replace them with some others! It is better to replace bad habits with habits of charity—or with nothing at all.

Paul uses the image of yeast to make this point when he writes to the Corinthians. We often think of yeast as something good that helps make a good loaf of bread rise. But he imagines it as something else—an impurity that gets in the way of a good, hearty unyeasted loaf.

If yeast has gone bad, we replace it with yeast that is good. But to Paul, yeast was never good to begin with. So, if it's bad, get rid of it and bake without it. He writes, "Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough, inasmuch as you are unleavened." He continues, "Let us celebrate the feast, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

So, put away those bad pre-Lenten habits of malice and wickedness. And celebrate Easter the way God made it—in sincerity and truth! Happy Easter!
