1 Juan 5:1-6

HIMNO, ALEGANCIA Y CREDO

Cuando cantamos el himno nacional, recitamos el juramento de fidelidad o enarbolamos la bandera en casa, los ciudadanos realizamos una acción que expresa quiénes somos y en qué creemos. No tenemos que recitar toda la constitución. Basta con promulgar un símbolo más pequeño pero central de nuestro país.

En la iglesia, recitamos nuestro credo todas las semanas. Y en Pascua renovamos nuestras promesas bautismales, que ponen el credo en forma de preguntas y respuestas. No tenemos que recitar toda la Biblia ni el catecismo completo. Decimos este texto más pequeño para expresar quiénes somos y en qué creemos. Es un símbolo de nuestra fe.

La Pascua es la temporada que renueva nuestra fe. Nuestra creencia central es la resurrección de Jesucristo, el Hijo de Dios. Cuando nos aferramos a esa fe, todo lo demás encaja.

Juan escribe en su primera carta: "Todo el que cree que Jesús es el Cristo es engendrado por Dios". Cada Pascua, los catecúmenos que se preparan para este día profesan su fe en Jesús. En esa fe son bautizados. Nacen de nuevo. Son engendrados por Dios.

Nuestra fe de Pascua nos ayudará a superar los malos momentos y agregará significado a nuestros días felices. Jesús es el Cristo, el ungido de Dios, el redentor prometido, y ha resucitado. Él es nuestro himno, nuestra lealtad y nuestro credo.

Sunday's Reflections

1 John 5:1-6

ANTHEM, ALLEGIANCE, AND CREED

When we sing the national anthem, recite the pledge of allegiance, or fly the flag at home, we citizens perform an action that expresses who we are and what we believe. We do not have to recite the entire constitution. It is enough to enact a smaller but central symbol of our country.

At church, we recite our creed every week. And on Easter we renew our baptismal promises—which put the creed in question-and-answer form. We do not have to recite the entire bible or the whole catechism. We say this smaller text to express who we are and what we believe. It is a symbol of our faith.

Easter is the season that renews our faith. Our central belief is the resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. When we hold fast to that faith, everything else falls in line.

John writes in his first letter, "Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is begotten by God." Every Easter, those who were catechumens preparing for this day profess their belief in Jesus. In that faith they are baptized. They are born again. They are begotten by God.

Our Easter faith will see us through bad times and add meaning to our happy days. Jesus is the Christ, the anointed one of God, the promised redeemer, and he is risen. He is our anthem, our allegiance, and our creed.
