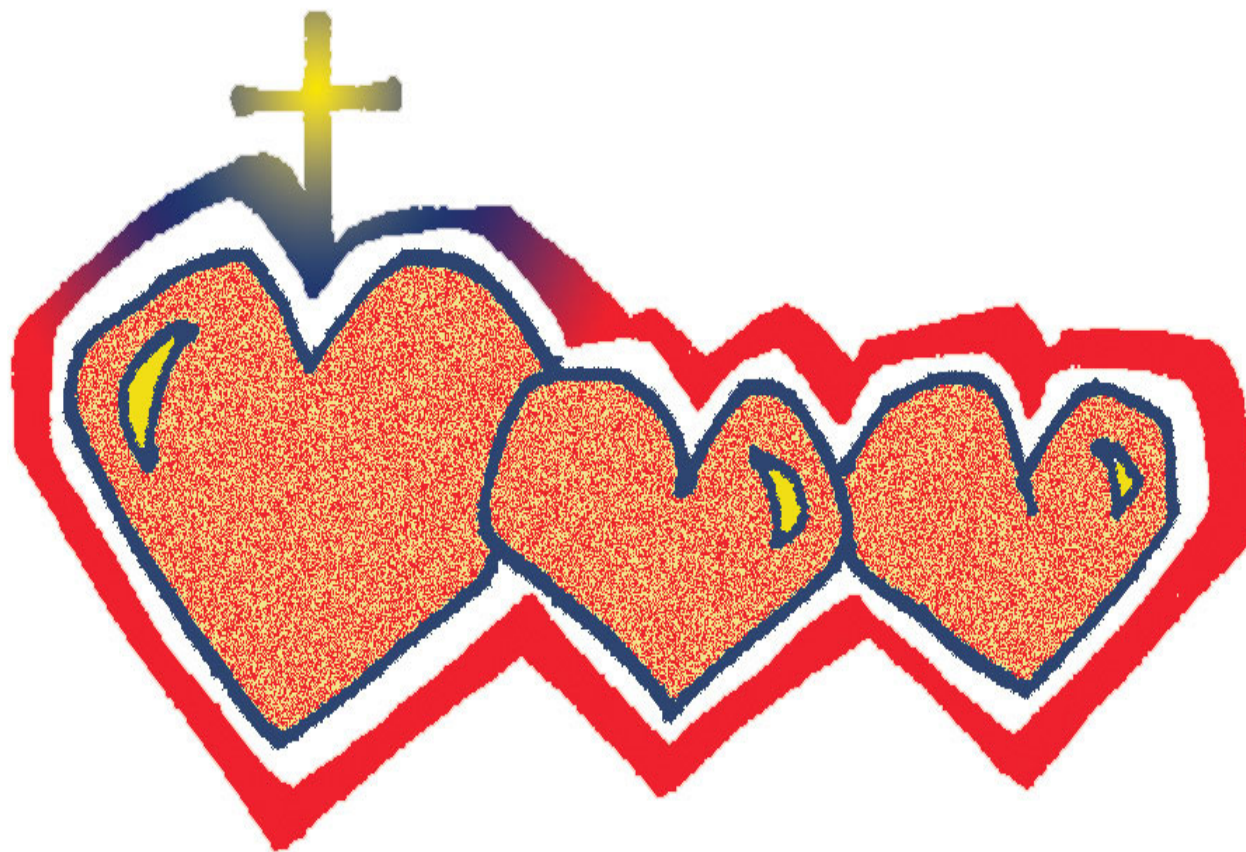

DID YOU KNOW

The Calcasieu Cajun Club was formed just after the completion of the new Church complex in 1985. The sole purpose of the CCC was to raise funds to pay off the Church Building debt.

The fundraising efforts began with hosting the Annual Calcasieu Cajun Festival, as well as two Bingo sessions per week, Wednesday mornings and Friday evenings. With the extra help of the CCC, the \$3.5 million dollar debt was paid off in November 1995. The CCC fund raising efforts resulted in donating approximately one million dollars to this debt.

Currently, the CCC only has Bingo on Wednesday morning. All funds are donated directly to the parish and in 2013, the CCC donated \$18,000.

The OLPS Altar Society hosts a cake raffle at each weekly Bingo which has resulted in approximately \$2,500 per year which is used to purchase specific items for the parish.
