

# Mass seating

We are very excited to welcome you back to church beginning Monday, May 25th for the Memorial Day Mass at 9:00 a.m. The parish staff has been working diligently to maximize the now-limited capacity of the church and hall in order to honor the state and diocesan social distancing guidelines. In an effort to make things go a little smoother, we have organized the sections of church to accommodate different household sizes and wanted to make you aware in advance of coming. The sections have all been taped off with the same four colors you see below. You will notice that every other pew is blocked off entirely and not to be used. Thank you for your cooperation.

The yellow sections will accommodate a group of 2 (left side) and a group of 4 (right side) in each pew with 6 feet in between groups. You will see two pieces of tape on the inside of each pew marking the boundary of each group size.

The green section is built for groups of 2. One group can be at the end of the row in the chairs and the other group at the opposite end of the row and there is 6 feet in between.

The blue section is built for groups of 3. One group of three on each end of the pew with 6 feet in between.

The purple sections are for families of varying sizes including 5 or more if you want to all sit in one pew and not divide up. Below you will see the group size listed on each pew in that section.

Staff and ushers will be available at every Mass to help guide you. We are most grateful for your patience as we find our way back together!
