Defined Objectives for 2020 Reaccreditation**

Student Performance Objective #1

1) By 2027, students at Hudson Catholic Regional High School will demonstrate a 5% improvement in math and language arts skills as measured by:

A) Pre-ACT scores obtained in freshmen and sophomore year compared to ACT scores in junior year in ELA and mathematics;

Baseline: We want to increase our current ELA average in the 9th Grade on the Pre-ACT from a local composite score of 14.2 to 14.9.

Baseline: We want to increase our current ELA average in the 10th Grade on the Pre-ACT from a local composite score of 15.3 to 16.0.

Baseline: We want to increase our current mathematics average in the 9th Grade on the Pre-ACT from a local composite score of 15.8 to 16.6.

Baseline: We want to increase our current mathematics average in the 10th Grade on the Pre-ACT from a local composite score of 16.7 to 17.5.

B) A 5% increase in the number of students enrolled in a full four-year mathematics curriculum;

Baseline: For the 2018-2019 school year, 93% (111 out of 119) seniors were enrolled in a fourth-year mathematics course.



Student Performance Objective #2

2) By 2027, students at Hudson Catholic Regional High School will demonstrate a 10% improvement in enrollment and successful completion of the Saint Peter's University ACE's Program as measured by:

A) More students maintaining a "B" or better in their Hudson Catholic classes;

Baseline: For the 2018-2019 year, 100 juniors maintained a B in their Hudson Catholic classes.

Baseline: For the 2018-2019 year, 111 seniors maintained a B in their Hudson Catholic classes.

B) A better promotion of the vetting process to students and parents in the marketing of the same process to all four grade levels and prospective incoming students and their parents.

Baseline: 80% (51 of 64) of applicants were approved by teachers to take ACE courses at Saint Peter's University in the Fall of 2018 and the Spring of 2019, but only 30% of the eligible pool of students (211) applied.

Baseline: Earlier and more aggressive efforts to increase the number of students enrolled in Saint Peter's University ACE's classes.



Organizational Capacity Objective #1

3) By 2027, Hudson Catholic Regional High School will see improved safety features as measured by:

- A) Improved entrance and exit security systems on all exterior doors of the school building;
- B) Installation of more security cameras within and around the school building by 20%;
- C) Effective training procedures and workshops for all faculty and staff at a minimum of twice a year primarily focusing on evacuation and live shooter drills.

Baseline: For the 2018-2019 school year, all faculty and staff partook in two evacuation and live shooter drills, once in the fall and once in the spring.
