

**Archdiocese of Anchorage-Juneau**  
**Safe Environment Online Training Instructions**  
**How to complete the online training (required every two years)**

The Archdiocese of Anchorage-Juneau Safe Environment Training for Clergy, Religious, Employees and Volunteers is available online. It requires approximately 60 to 90 minutes to complete.

In December of 2020, The Archdiocese of Anchorage-Juneau's website (AoAJ.org) was launched. Therefore, the parishes of both the former Diocese of Juneau and the former Archdiocese of Anchorage can continue to access the online Safe Environment Training Site through this new websites.

**Important information to note that while the Office of Safe Environment continues the merging of two former dioceses, from AoAJ.org, there are two separate ways to access the online training:**

- **Parishioners from Southcentral Alaska can access the safe environment online training by going to AoAj.org and the Safe Environment Training Tab and clicking on [Safe and Sacred Environment Adult Online Training website](#) (WEB for parishes in Southcentral)**
